Easy to make, even for beginners, these bracelets are perfect for getting started with jewelry making or for quickly crafting several styles to wear on their own or layered together. Since they're strung on elastic cord, they're comfortable, easy to slip on, and fit any wrist.

For this tutorial, we've selected pretty, irregularly shaped, faceted round beads made of translucent resin in shades of Caribbean blue, moss green, and marbled topaz, paired with gold-tone stainless steel beads to add a touch of sparkle. A simple yet effective combination that highlights the colors and transparency of the beads.

The best part about this project? It's completely customizable! Vary the colors, mix several shades on a single bracelet, add charms, or combine different bead shapes to create unique designs that reflect your personality.

Which material to use for Resin Round Bead Bracelets?

Elastic cord Transparent 0.80mm x 8 m
Ref. : FC-389
Quantity : 1



4x3.5mm Stainless steel 304L Flattened round beads - Gold Tone x20
Ref. : INX-777
Quantity : 1



14 mm irregularly shaped faceted round bead made of clear resin - Moss green x1
Ref. : KSF-382
Quantity : 11



Round irregular faceted beads 14 mm translucent resin - Caribbean Blue x1
Ref. : KSF-387
Quantity : 11



16 mm irregularly shaped faceted round bead made of translucent resin - Marbled topaz x1
Ref. : KSF-399

steps

Perles & Co Step 1/1

Cut about 30 cm of elastic thread.

Then, alternately thread a faceted irregular round bead in the color of your choice and a round gold bead.

Repeat this sequence until you reach the desired length.

For each of the bracelets featured in this tutorial, we used 11 faceted beads and 11 round gold beads.

Once all the beads are strung, tie a surgeon's knot to close your bracelet. If this is your first project using elastic cord, this guide may help: [How to Close an Elastic Bracelet?](#)
