Perles & Co Step 1/2

Bracelet 1

Start by measuring your wrist circumference. Then cut a piece of elastic cord that's slightly longer than your wrist circumference so you'll have enough room to tie the knot comfortably and adjust the bracelet's size if needed. For this design, we used about 25 cm of elastic cord.

Next, thread a blue 12 x 11 mm tube bead, followed by a white one, then a red one, and finally a gold spacer bead. Repeat this sequence 4 times in total.

Once all the beads are strung, adjust the length of the bracelet to fit your wrist, then tie a surgeon's knot to close it.

Your first bracelet is finished!

Perles & Co Step 2/2

Bracelet 2

Cut about 25 cm of elastic cord.

Thread a blue curved tube bead, followed by a white one, and then a red one. Repeat this sequence 3 times in total, until you reach the desired length.

Then adjust the bracelet to fit your wrist and secure it with a surgeon's knot.

And there you go—your second bracelet is already finished!
