How do you make a bag handle out of resin beads?

Resin beads—whether bold or more understated—are emerging as one of the biggest trends of the moment, just like beaded bag handles, which transform an everyday accessory into a truly distinctive piece. I'd like to show you how to make your own resin bead bag handle—for a result that's both trendy and unique, crafted entirely by your own hands.

Suitable even for absolute beginners, this easy tutorial takes just 20 minutes to complete—perfect for a quick and satisfying creative project. No need to be an expert: just follow the steps one by one to create a neat handle, ready to give any bag a fresh twist.

In this tutorial, I'll show you a main version in fresh, bright shades of turquoise blue and green. But the bead-decorated bag handle can be adapted to any style: you'll find two possible variations—a pink and burgundy combination paired with silver hardware for an elegant look, as well as a brown and beige version accented with gold hardware for a warmer, more autumnal vibe. This gives you plenty of options to mix things up depending on your current tastes or the bags you want to transform. That's also the whole point of making your own accessories: being able to fully customize them by choosing from [the wide selection of resin beads available on our site](#) to create a bag handle that truly reflects your style.

Perles & Co Step 1/6

Start by cutting about 60 centimeters of wire. You can adjust the length of wire you cut depending on how long you want your handle to be.

Thread the wire through a crimp bead, then add a wire protector by threading the wire through both holes. Thread the wire back through the crimp bead and squeeze it tightly against the wire protector. Finally, crimp the bead using crimping pliers.



Perles & Co Step 2/6

Place a crimp cap over the crimp bead, then crimp it closed using pliers.

You can then open a jump ring and slide it into the wire protector before closing it.



Perles & Co Step 3/6

You can start stringing the beads in the following order.



Perles & Co Step 4/6

Here is the order in which to string the beads. Then add the round Lobster Clasps.



Perles & Co Step 5/6

You can also make a pink/burgundy version using the silver embellishments.



Perles & Co Step 6/6

Or a brown/beige version with gold accents.
