In this DIY tutorial, learn how to make a pair of stainless steel hoop earrings with multiple charms: a trendy summer piece that's perfect for beginners.

This design combines stainless steel hoop earrings, a mother-of-pearl seashell pendant with pearlescent sheen, a gold-plated stainless steel seashell pendant, and delicate natural stone chip beads. Together, they create an elegant, airy look with real character.

Stainless steel is the go-to material for DIY jewelry: moisture-resistant, durable, and easy to care for, it's ideal for jewelry worn all summer long. Most of the findings used here are also available in a silver finish—do you prefer silver? Check out our selection of products to recreate this design in that finish.

Chip beads add a natural and unique touch—each stone has its own shape. You'll find a wide range of colors in our [selection](#) to personalize your creation: amazonite, rose quartz, amethyst, aventurine... so many possibilities for a result that reflects your style.

Jumpings open 5x0.7mm 316L gold-finished stainless steel x10

Perles & Co Step 1/6

Thread 3 chip beads onto a ball-head pin, then use a loopier pliers to make a loop at the end. You can also form the loop by hand by following our technical guide: [How to Make a Loop on a Pin or Jewelry Wire.](#)



Perles & Co Step 2/6

Repeat the previous step to make 2 chip bead charms.



Perles & Co Step 3/6

Count 7 links on the chain, then cut the 8th link using wire cutters. You can, of course, adjust this length to achieve your desired look by cutting the chain shorter or longer. Using an open jump ring, attach the mother-of-pearl shell pendant to one end of the chain. Perles & Co Step 4/6

Open a ring, then thread the following onto it: a chip bead charm, the chain with the mother-of-pearl seashell pendant. Close the ring, then attach it directly to the hoop by simply opening the hoop.



Perles & Co Step 5/6

Using an open ring, attach the stainless steel seashell charm to the second link from the top of the chain. Then add the second chip bead charm to the second link from the bottom, also using an open jump ring.



Perles & Co Step 6/6

Repeat all the steps one more time to make the second earring. Way to go! Your summer hoop earrings with multiple charms are now ready.
