How do you make a bracelet with colorful links?

Create a colorful, trendy beaded bracelet with this DIY jewelry-making tutorial. Learn how to make a link bracelet using the two-strand beading technique—a simple method that produces a truly unique look. This project is perfect for craft enthusiasts, whether they're beginners or passionate about handmade jewelry. Easy to customize, this bracelet can be adapted to suit your every whim by playing with the colors of the beads and the finishes.

To create this fashion jewelry piece, the links are made with 6/0 seed beads, which add volume and an ultra-trendy style. The separators and finishes are highlighted with gold 5/0 seed beads, which add a luminous and refined touch to the overall design. The beading is finished with a jade cord, allowing for an adjustable bracelet that fits any wrist thanks to the flat macramé knot technique.

This bracelet is the perfect accessory to pair with a summer outfit, to complement a stack of bracelets, or to give as a handmade gift. This tutorial will also introduce you to a new stringing technique that's both accessible and quick to make.

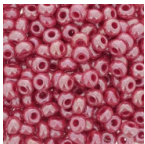
0.5mm braided nylon thread - Beige x9m

Perles & Co Step 1/9

First, cut two pieces of jade cord, each about 60 cm long.



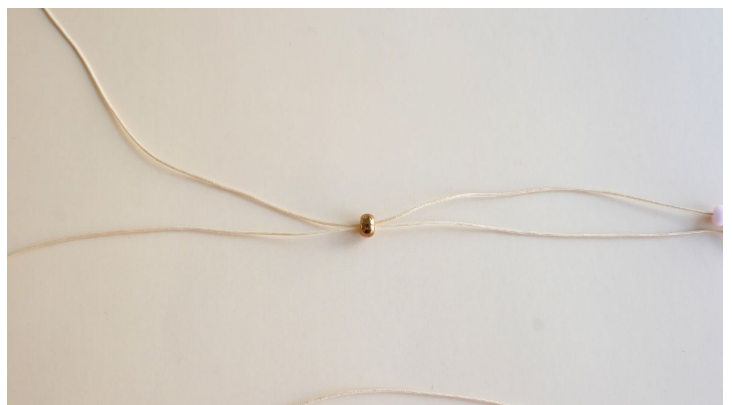
Perles & Co Step 2/9

Place the two strands one on top of the other. Thread 6 pale pink beads onto the first strand, then repeat the same step on the second strand.



Perles & Co Step 3/9

To secure your stringing, thread a gold bead by passing the top strand from left to right. Next, thread the bottom strand through the same bead, bringing it up from left to right. Gently pull on both strands to secure the assembly. Refer to the diagram.



Perles & Co Step 4/9

When you pull on both threads, the colored beads form a link. Alternate the colors as you like.



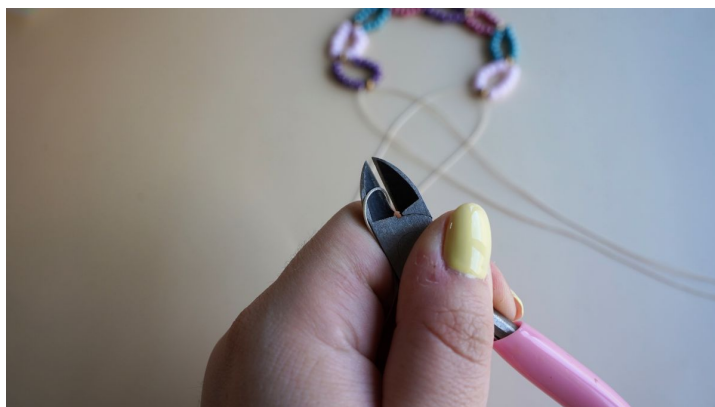
Perles & Co Step 5/9

Repeat the steps until you reach the desired length.



Perles & Co Step 6/9

You have now finished threading the cord. Next, we'll move on to making a flat macramé knot. To do this, cut a new piece of jade cord about 20 cm long.



Perles & Co Step 7/9

To make your flat macramé knot, I invite you to watch the video to achieve this result.



Perles & Co Step 8/9

Once you've finished tying your flat knot, cut off the excess thread used to tie it. Using a lighter, gently melt the remaining ends, then flatten them with the flat part of the lighter to seal the knot securely. You should be left with only the 4 strands used to adjust the bracelet.



Perles & Co Step 9/9

For a nice finish, tie a first knot in the center using both strands. Then thread on a bead in the color of your choice, and tie a second knot to hold it in place. Repeat these same steps on the other side of the bracelet. Your bracelet is now finished!
