

POLYMERIC TOUCAN BROOCH

Step 1

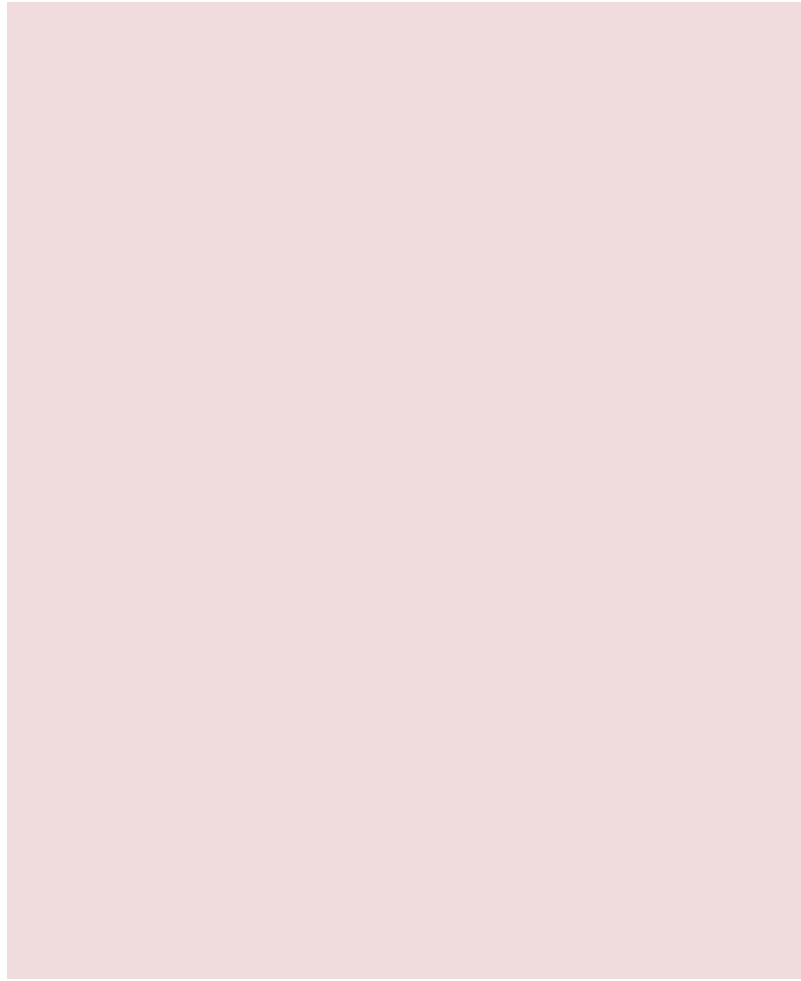
Print and cut your toucan template, Prepare your pasta portions, the amount of black dough is 3 times larger than that of the dyes.



2nd step

Make plates with each color, cut in 2 the black. Lay your template segments on their respective colors.



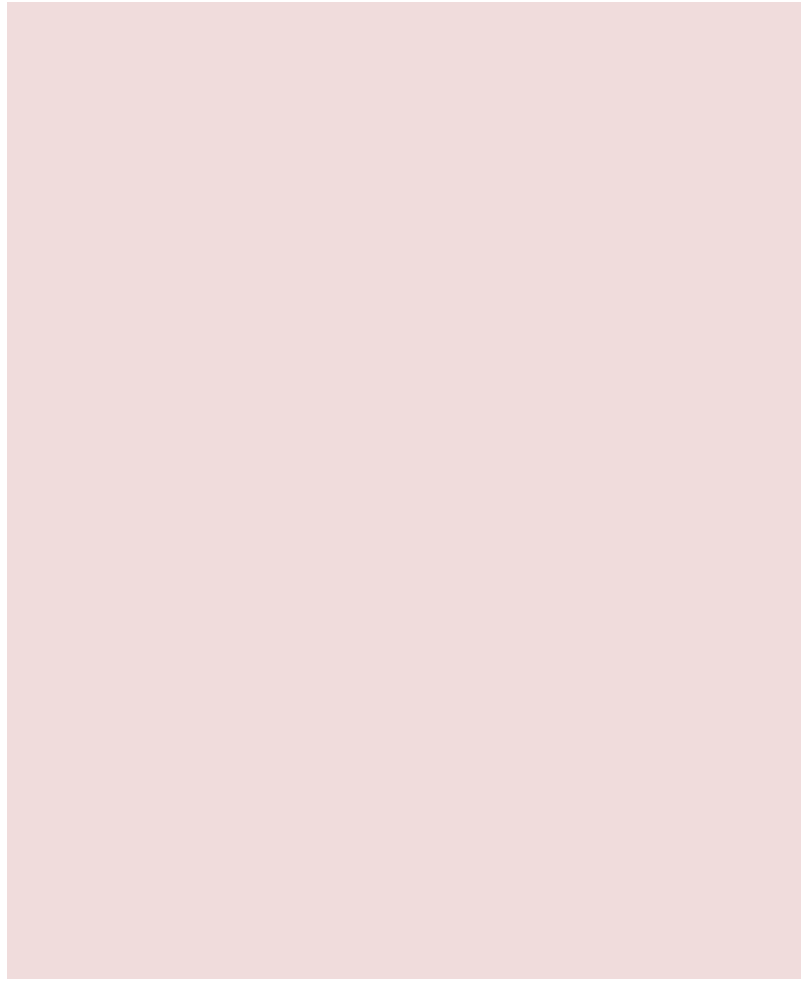


Step 3

Put all your shapes on the black plate. Make a tiny ball with blue dough and then a smaller one with black. Crush the blue ball with your blade, put on it the black ball.

Place your eye on the toucan, add a little black paste on the tip of the beak. Place baking paper on the toucan, make small rounds with your roll to erase the pasta fittings.



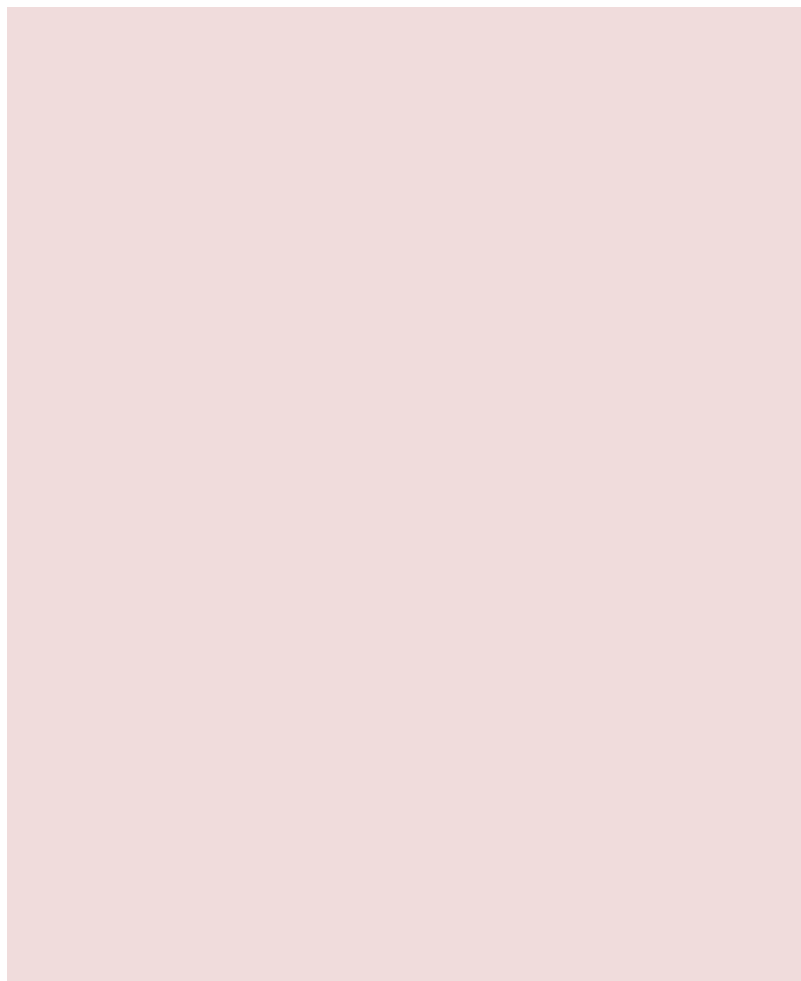


Step 4

Cut out the contours of your toucan with the blade. Gently press your finger on the edges to break the angles.

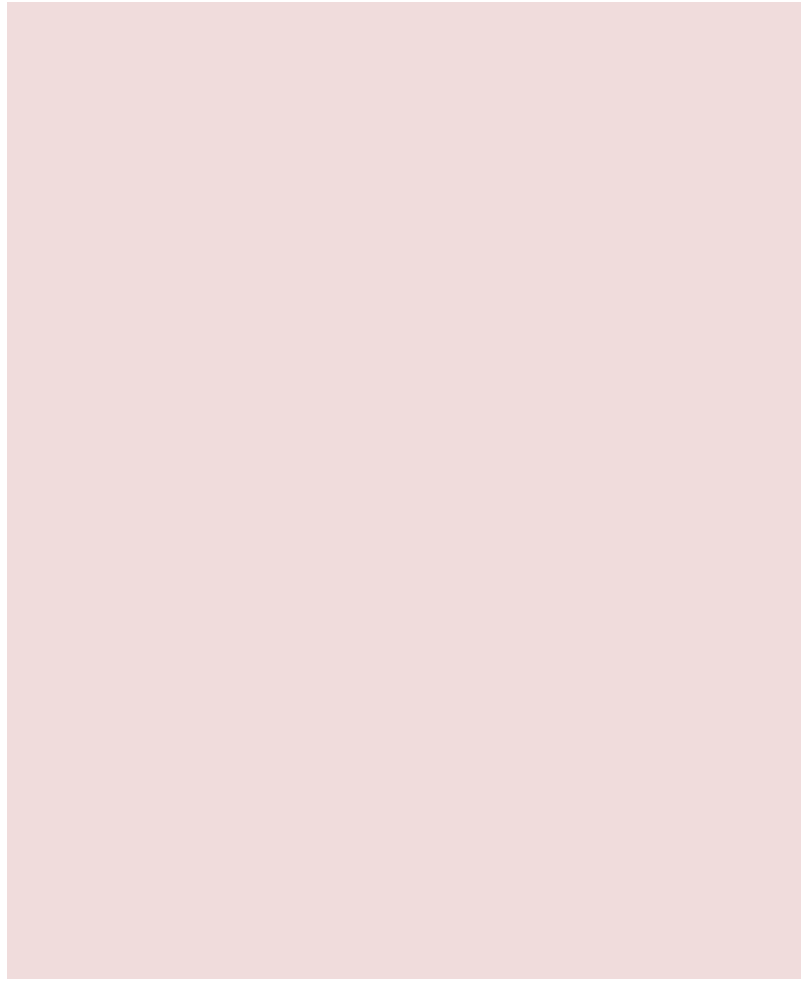
Bake at 120 degrees for 30 minutes.





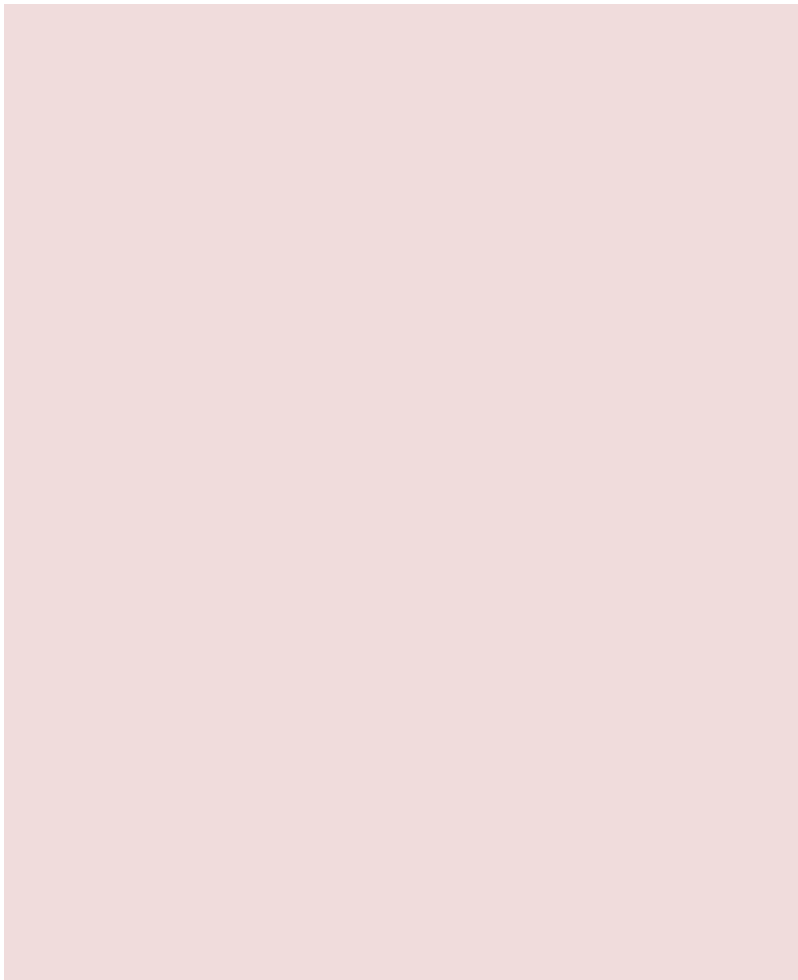
Step 5
Paint your toucan to revive the colors and protect it.





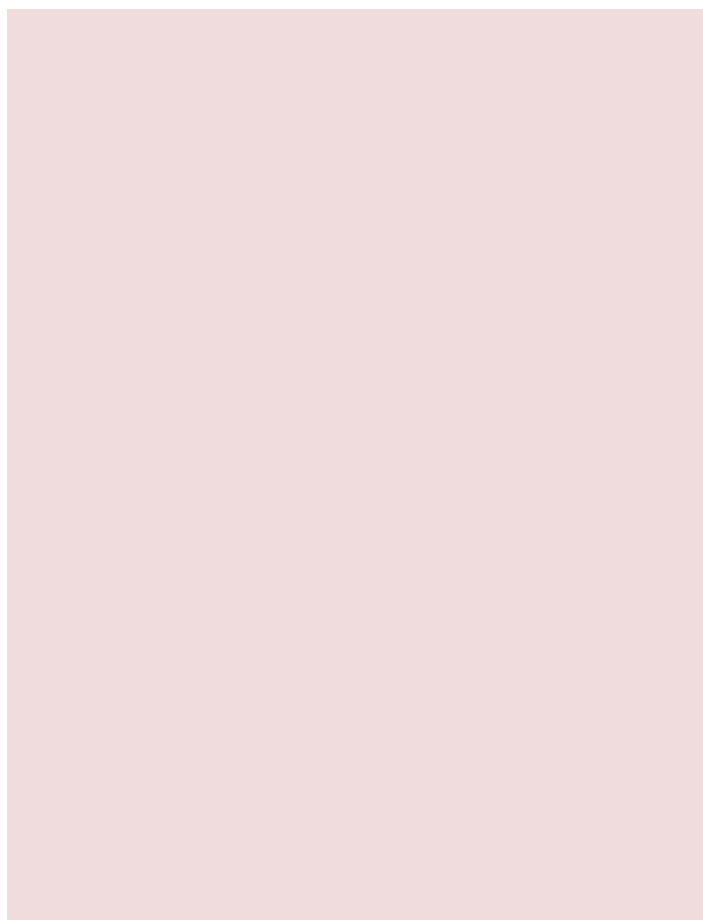
Step 6
Stick the pin to the back of your toucan.
