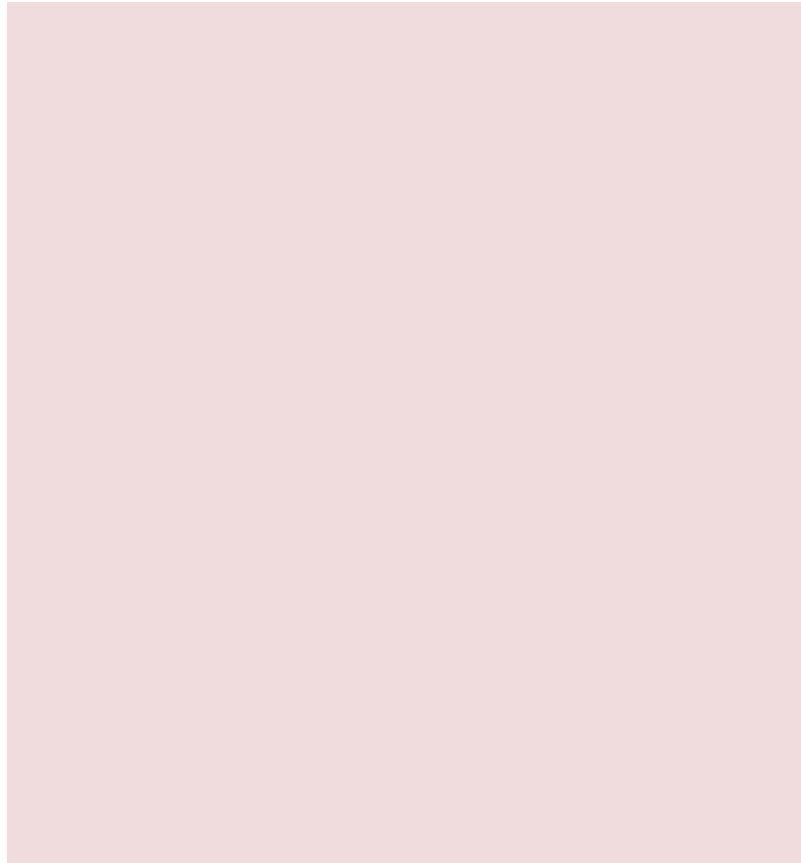

Step 1

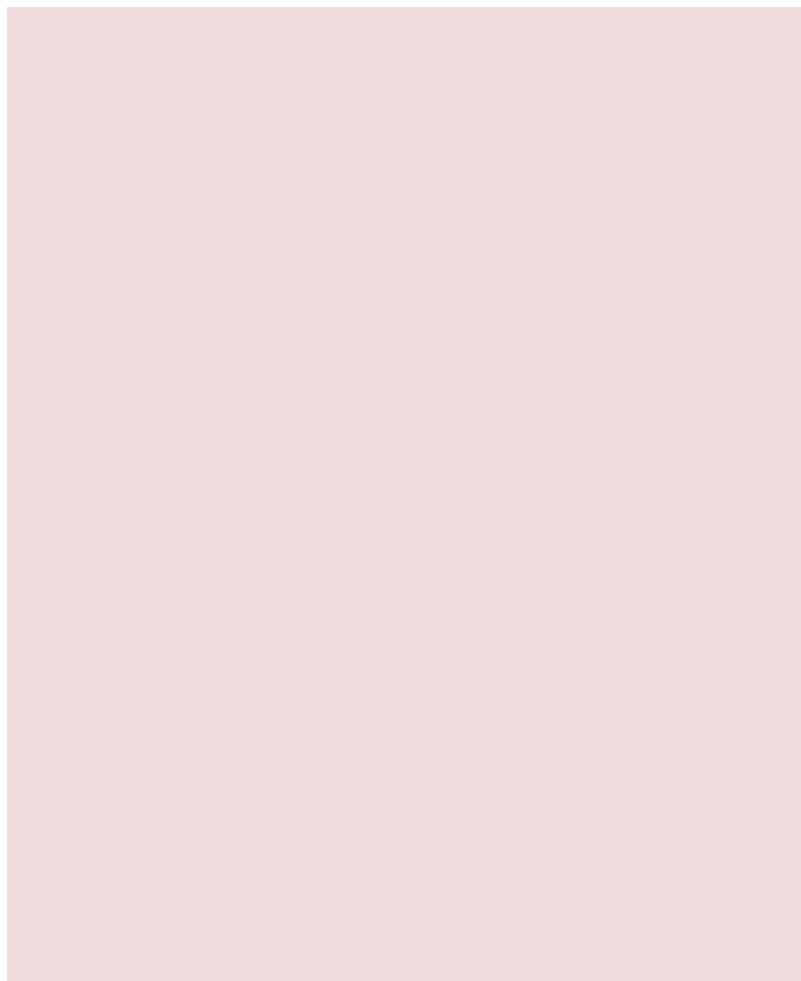
Knead your white bread and roll over to get a plate. Cut it into 3 rectangles.





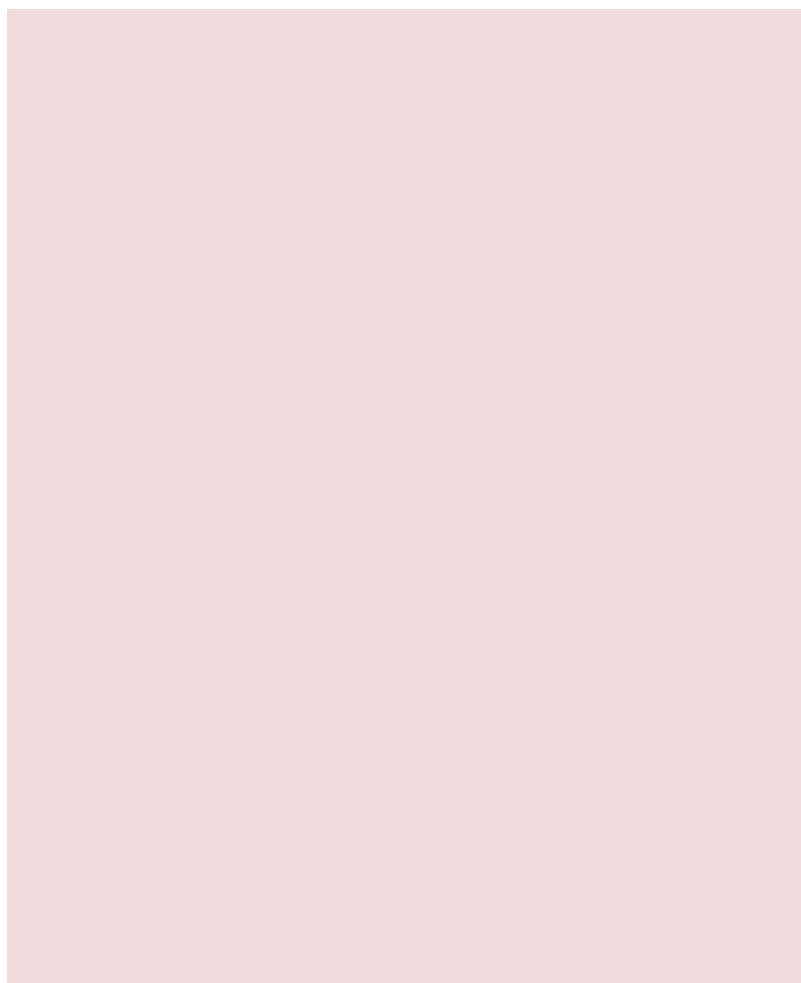
2nd step
Cut very thin slices of pasta with your blade on the different colors.





Step 3
Tear all the pasta tips with your fingers to obtain irregular confetti.

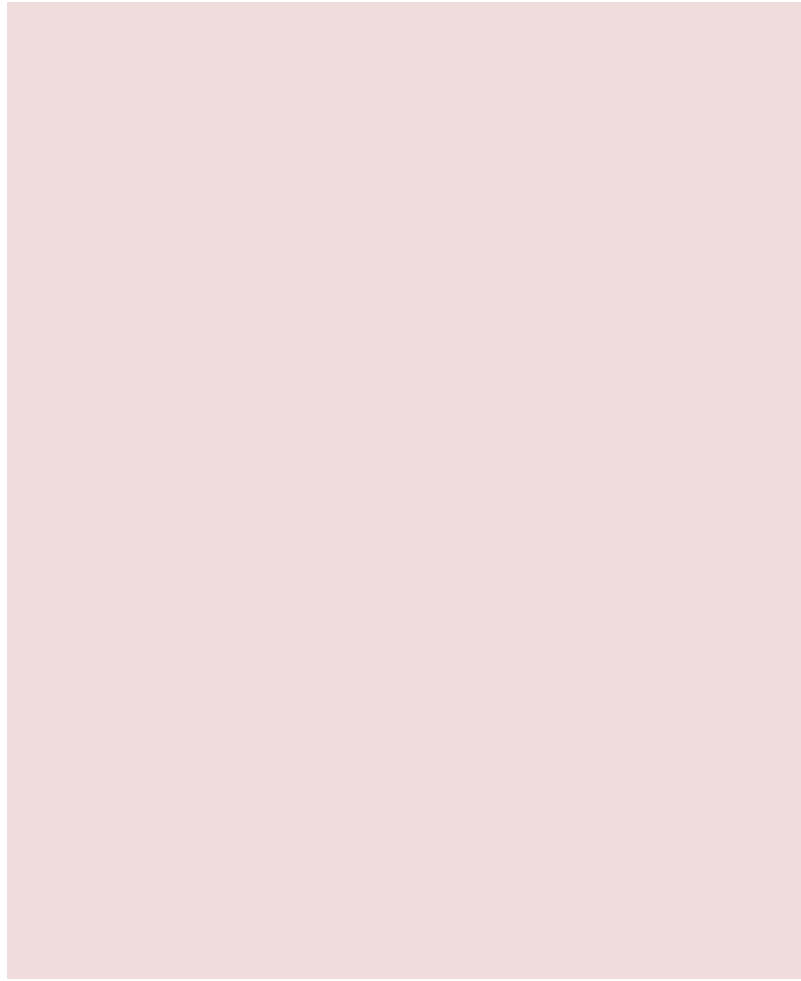




Step 4

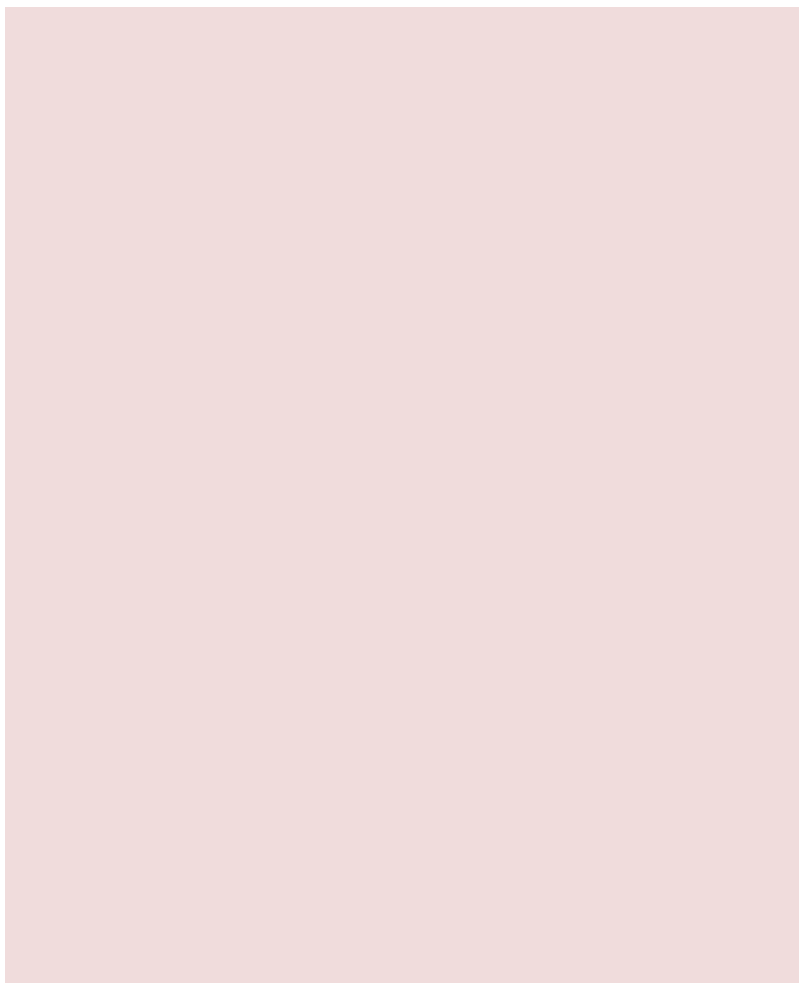
Divide your confetti on the 3 plates. Roll the roll to put everything on the same level.





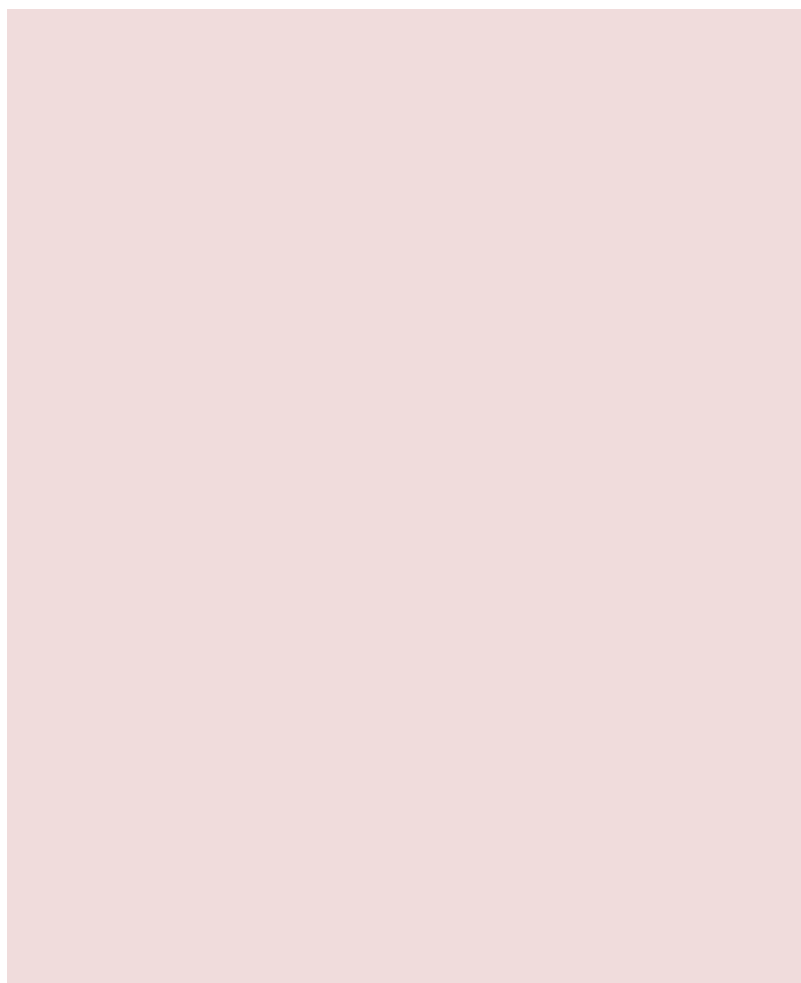
Step 5
Cover your cutlery by surrounding plates, cut the excess dough, do not overlay your pasta. Gently smooth the pasta fittings with your index finger. Cook your cutlery at 120 degrees for 30 minutes.

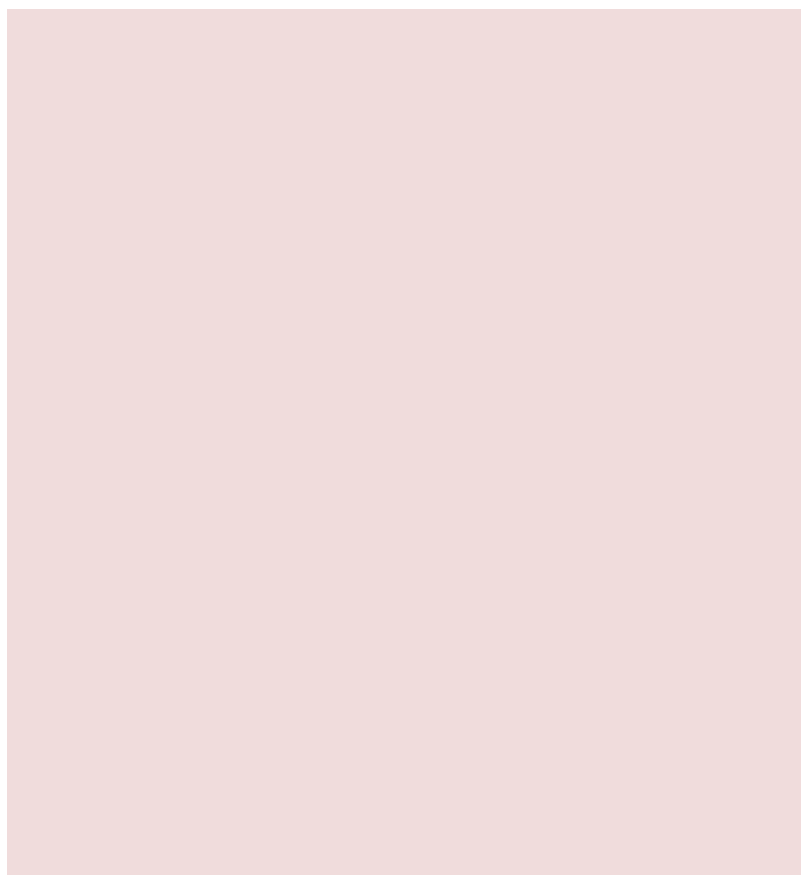




Step 6
Open your cutlery to protect and shine.
