How to integrate PureCrystal Spike Beads into a Miyuki weaving?

Discover the PureCrystal Spike Beads through this tutorial. These small beads of very good finish have been created to integrate perfectly with Myuki bead weaving. Use them in your Brick Siltch, Peyote or loom weaving. You can either integrate them into the weaving or add them on top.

If you used Galvanized Apricot Gold beads instead of duracoats, varnish the bracelet on both sides and wait until the varnish dries perfectly before making the other side.

Step 4: Weave the spike bead to the weaving using the four beads you added in step 2. Return to the end of the bracelet to attach the chain to the weaving



Step 5:
Pass the needle through a chain link and back into the end bead. Pass once again into the chain and then into the bead. Wedge the thread into the weaving and cut it



tep 6: Ressure the length of chain needed for your bracelet then fix the other end of the chain. Cut the chain in the middle to add the jumprings and the clas-
