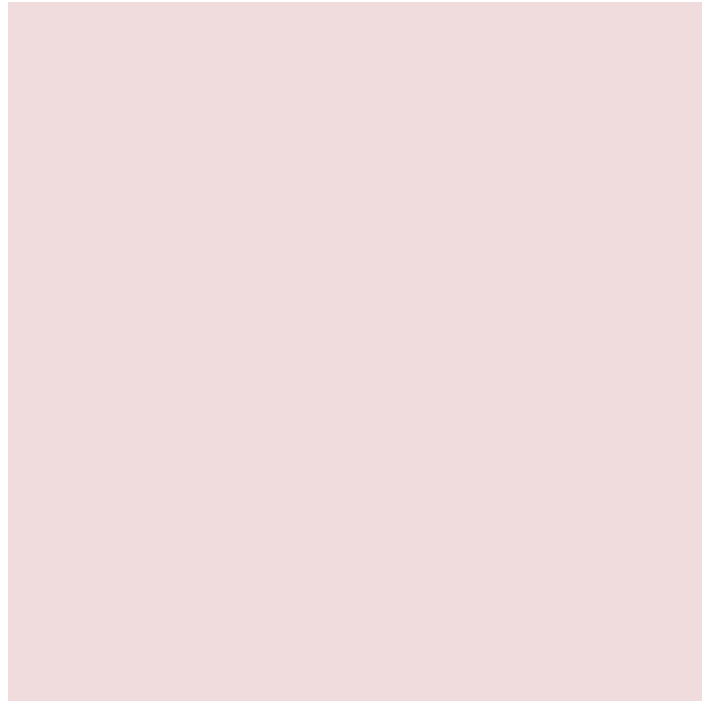

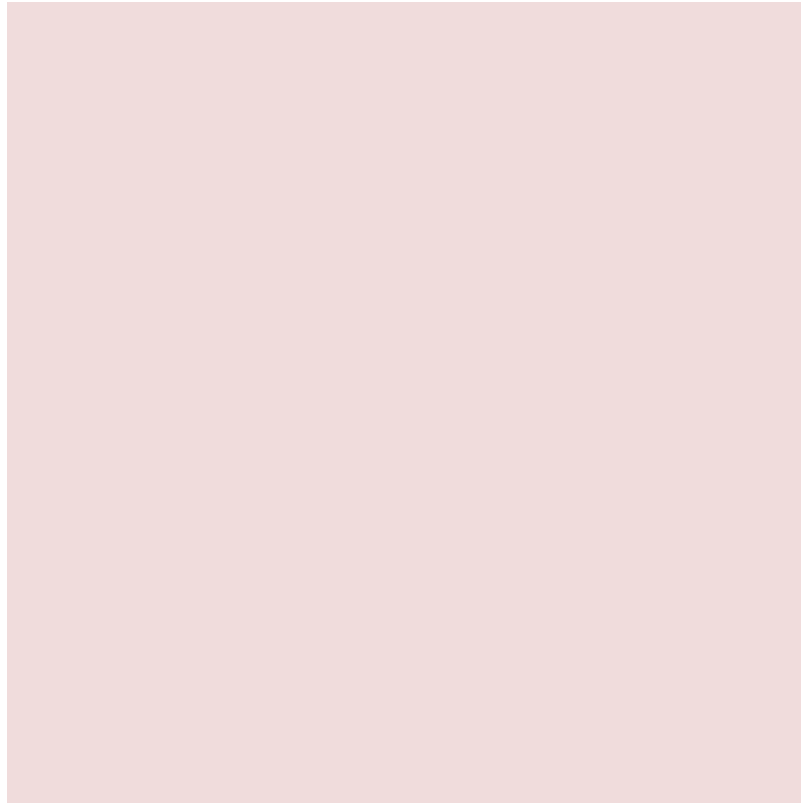
How to customize a pouch simply?

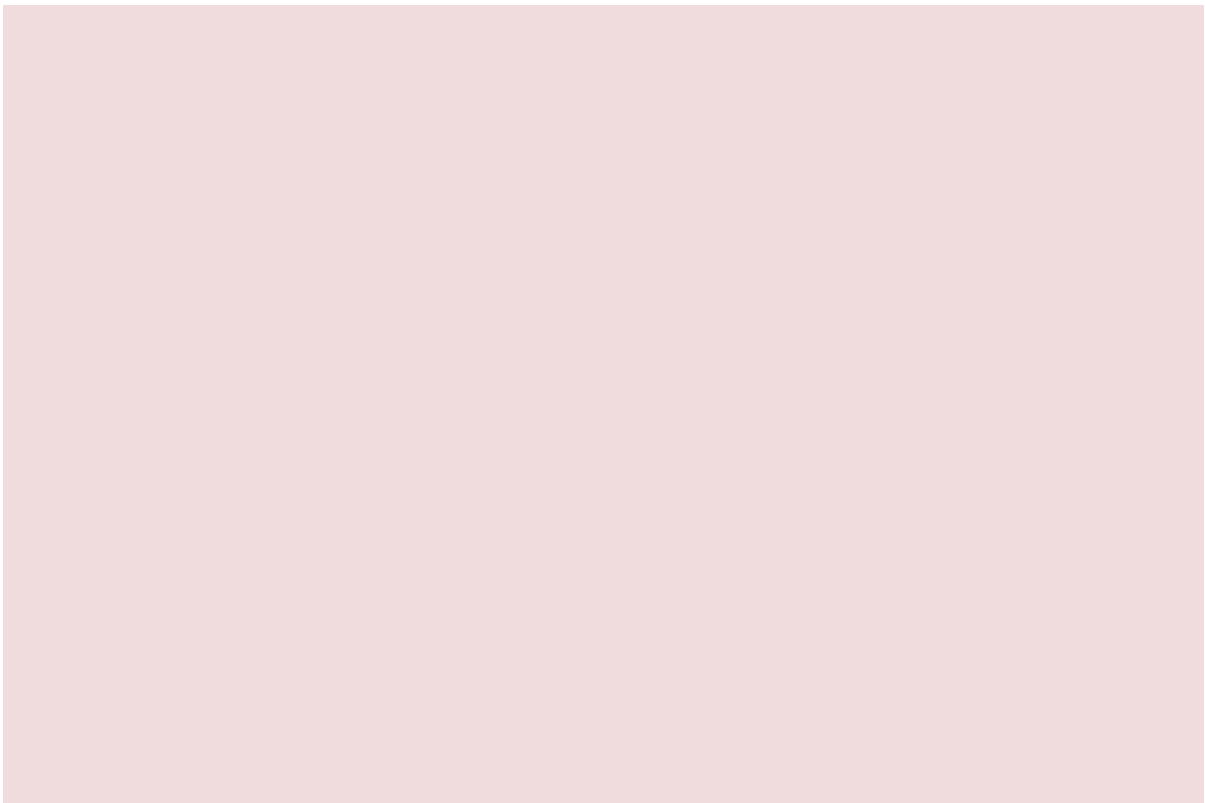

STEP 1

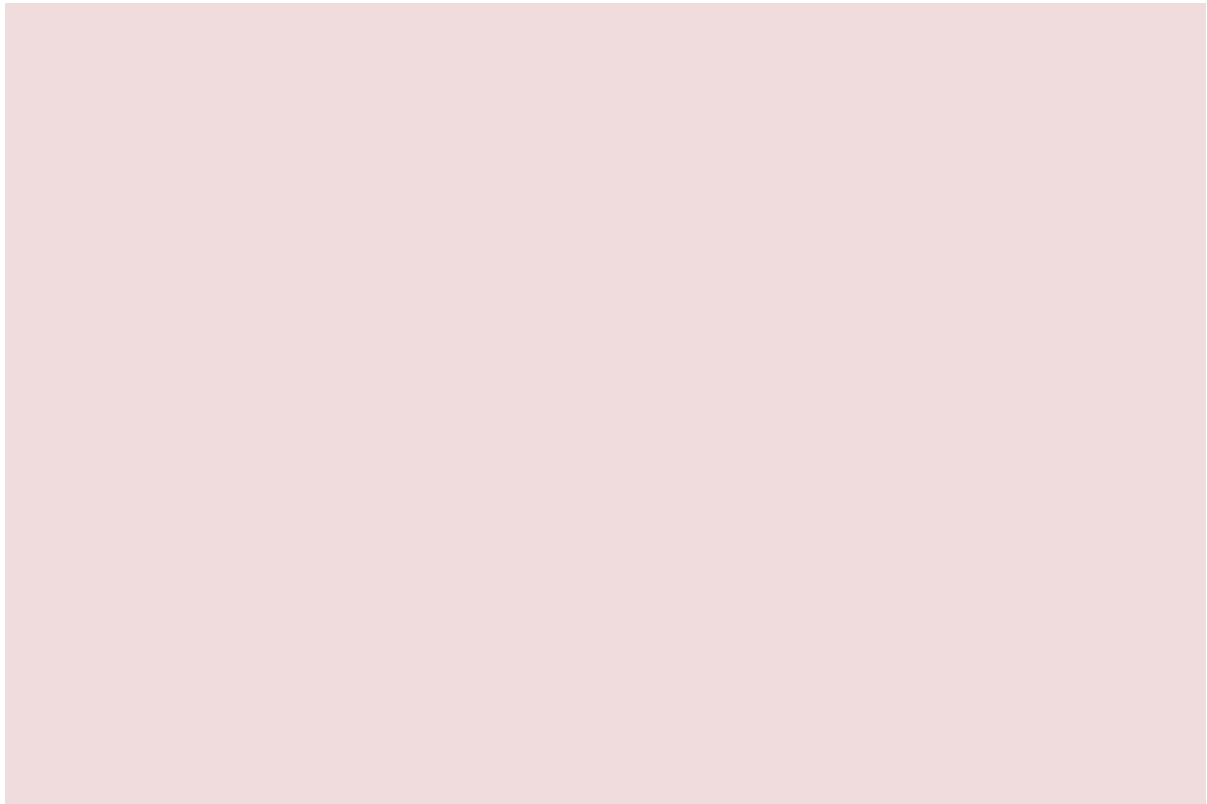
Cut a canvas canvas rectangle according to the desired location on the wallet. Always keep a margin of 1.5 holes of "security" or more for beginners.



2ND STEP



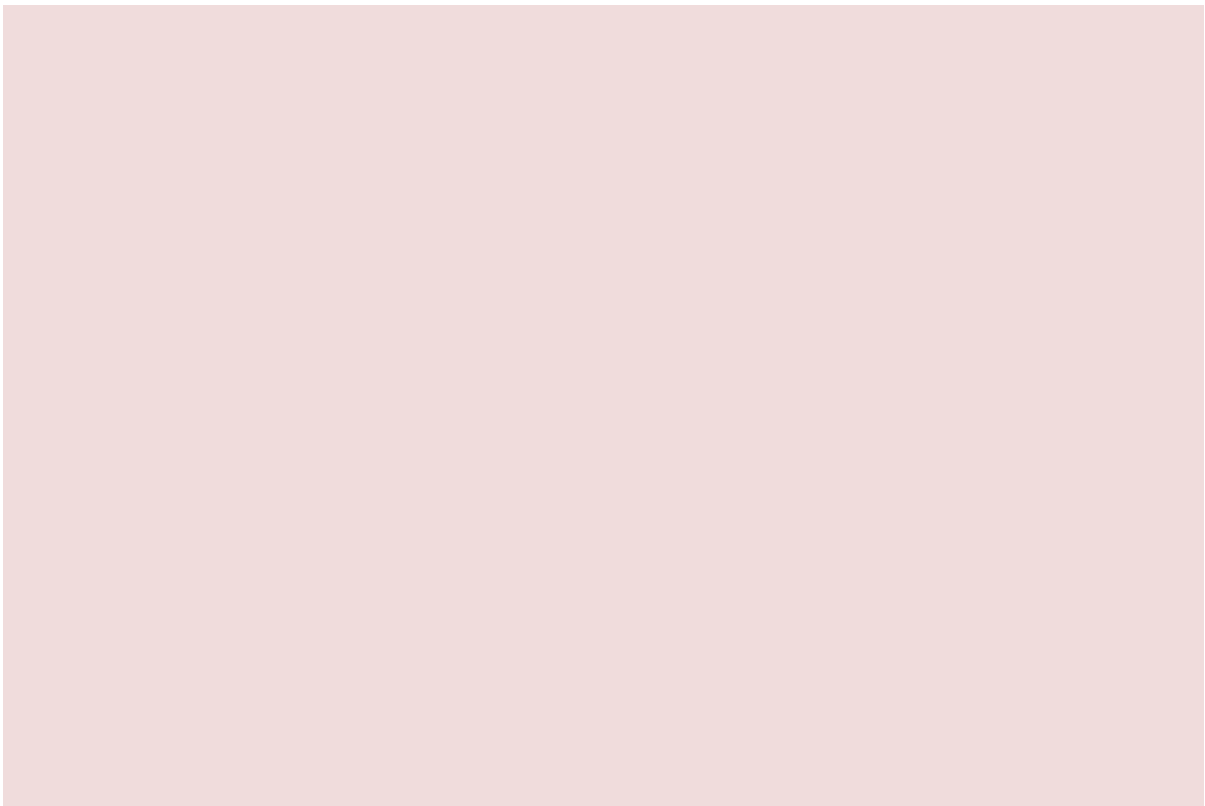
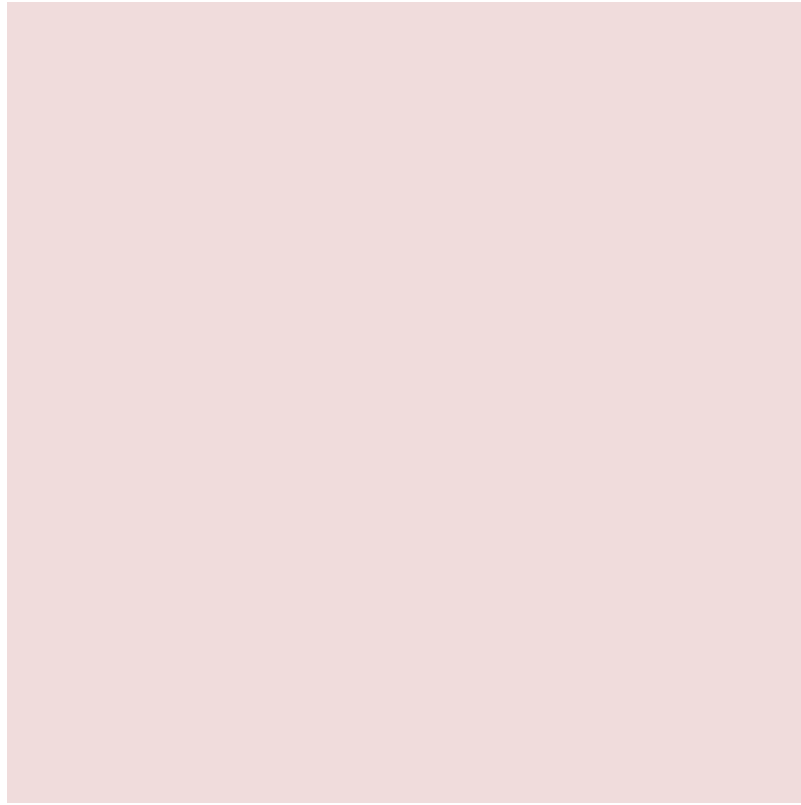
Draw on the felt the desired shapes on the canvas.



STEP 3

Prepare the bundles of wool. Go around a classic business card a number of times (you can count beforehand the points to tie to make only the number of strands needed) and cut up and down.





STEP 4

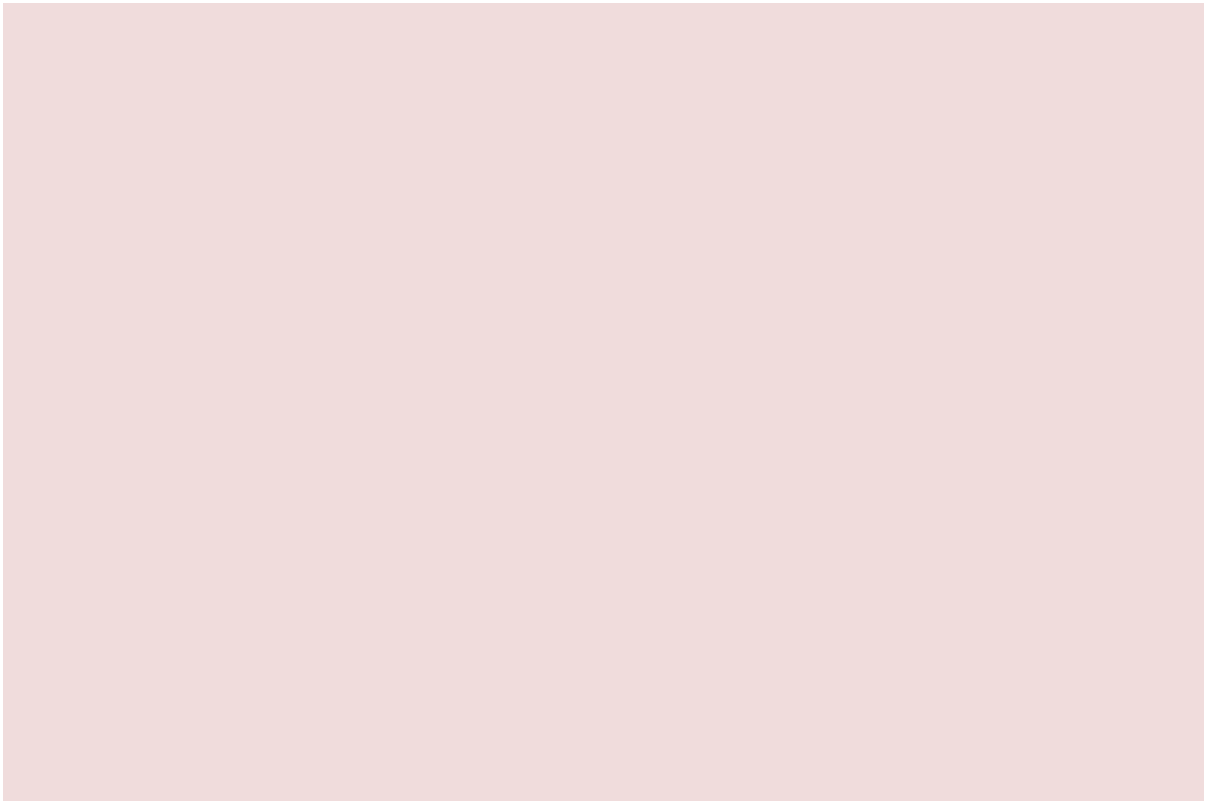
The lockstitch is a repetitive movement: with only one technique, we create all the motifs.

The technique: pass the hook in a hole, open the hook and pass the folded wool in 2.



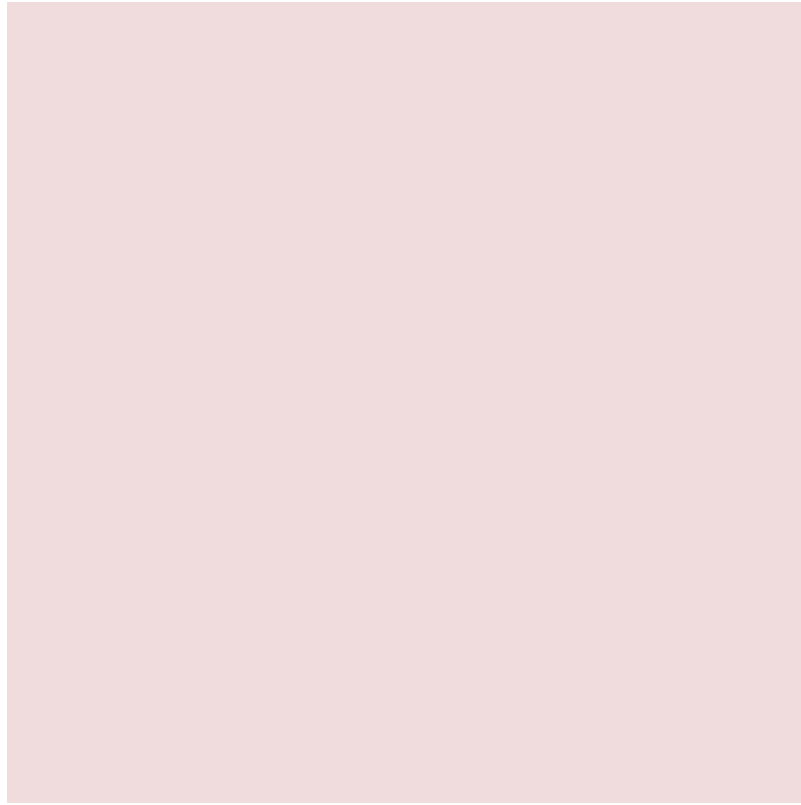


Pull gently (without pulling the wool out of the hole), the hook will close on its own.

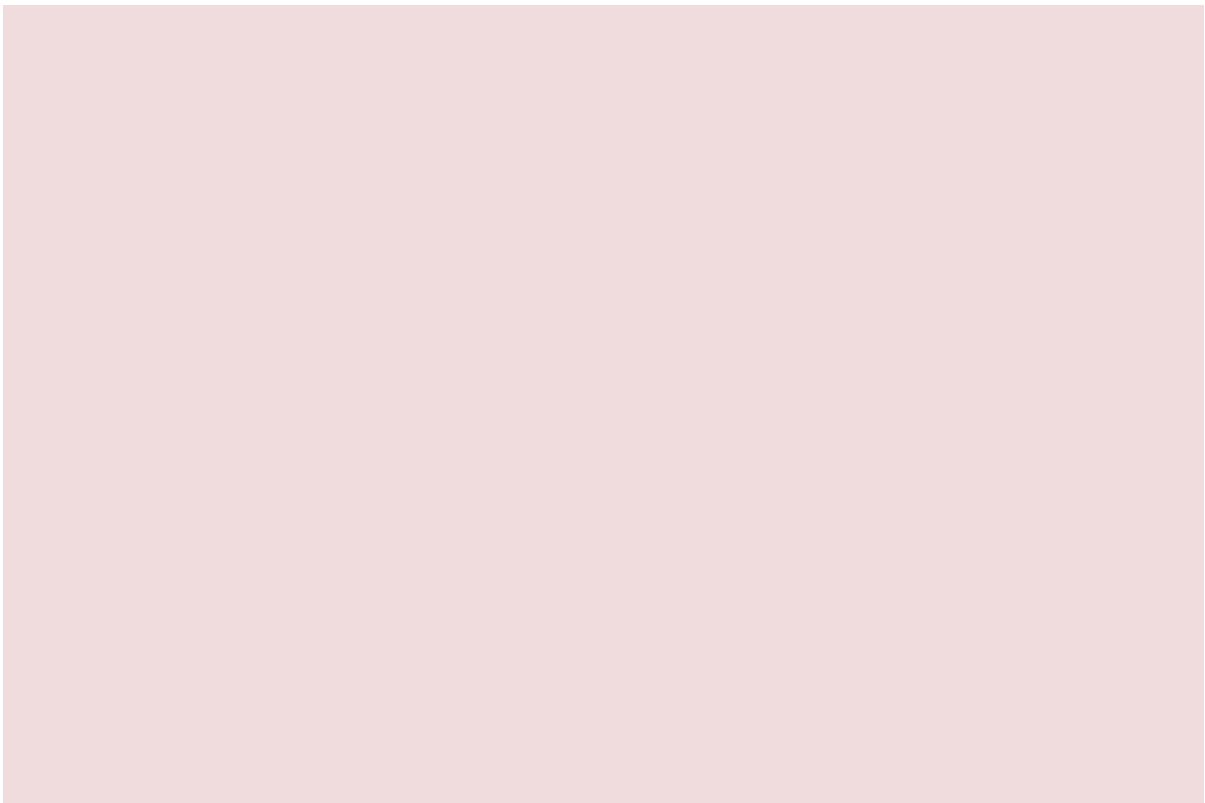


Go back inside the loop that formed to catch the 2 pieces of wool.





Pull to get the 2 pieces of wool into the loop.



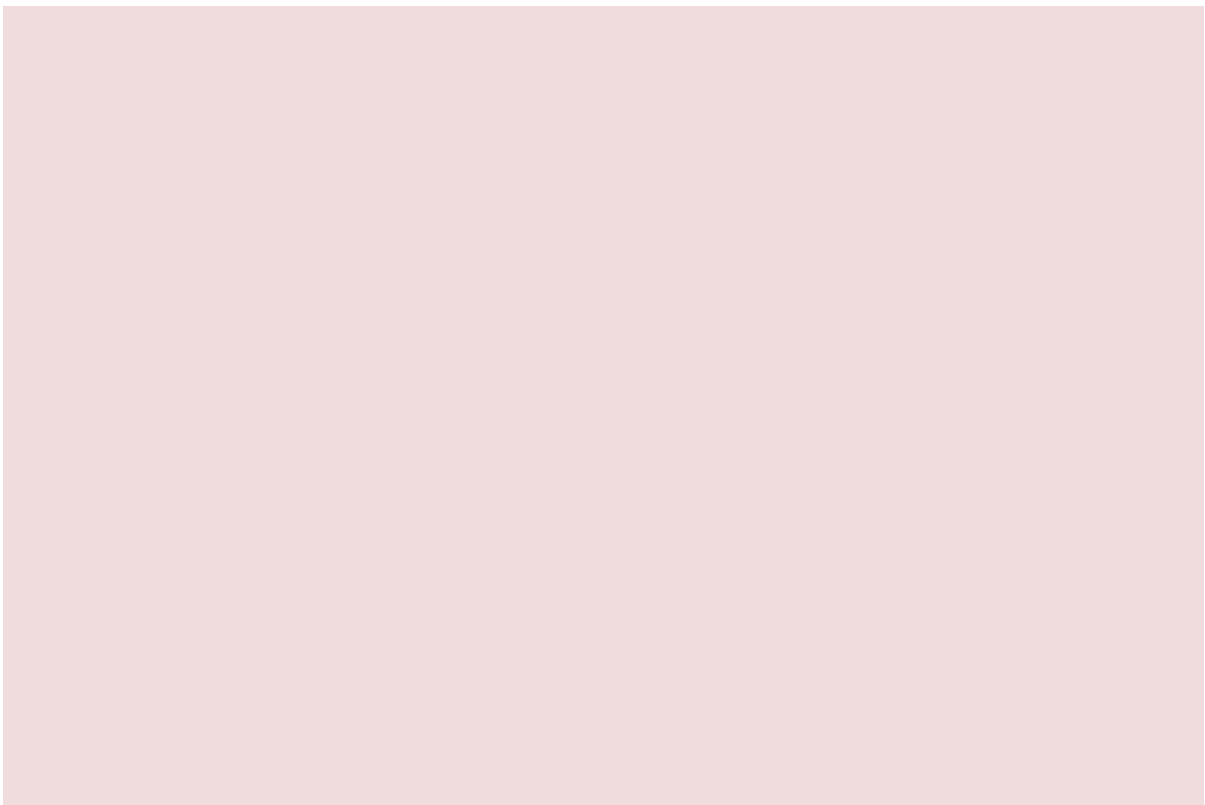
We start from the bottom up.





STEP 5

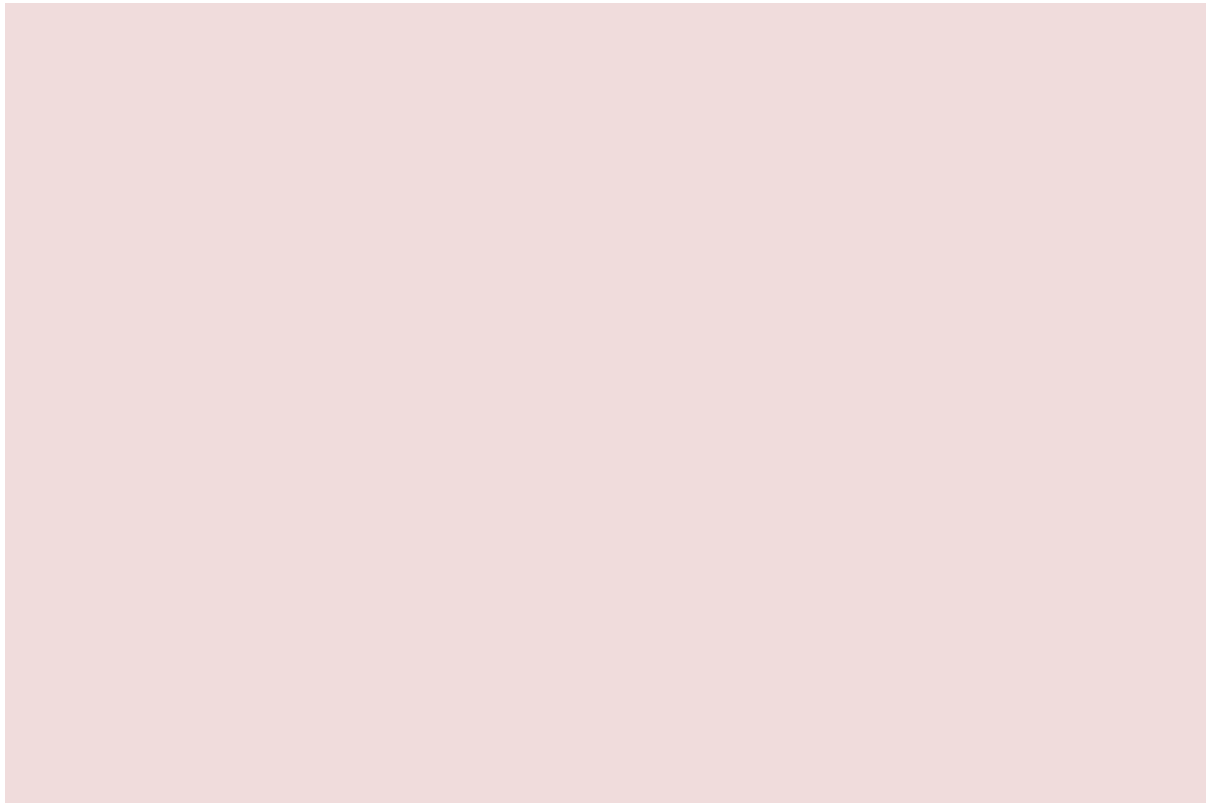
Repeat the process until you cover the entire canvas.



STEP 6



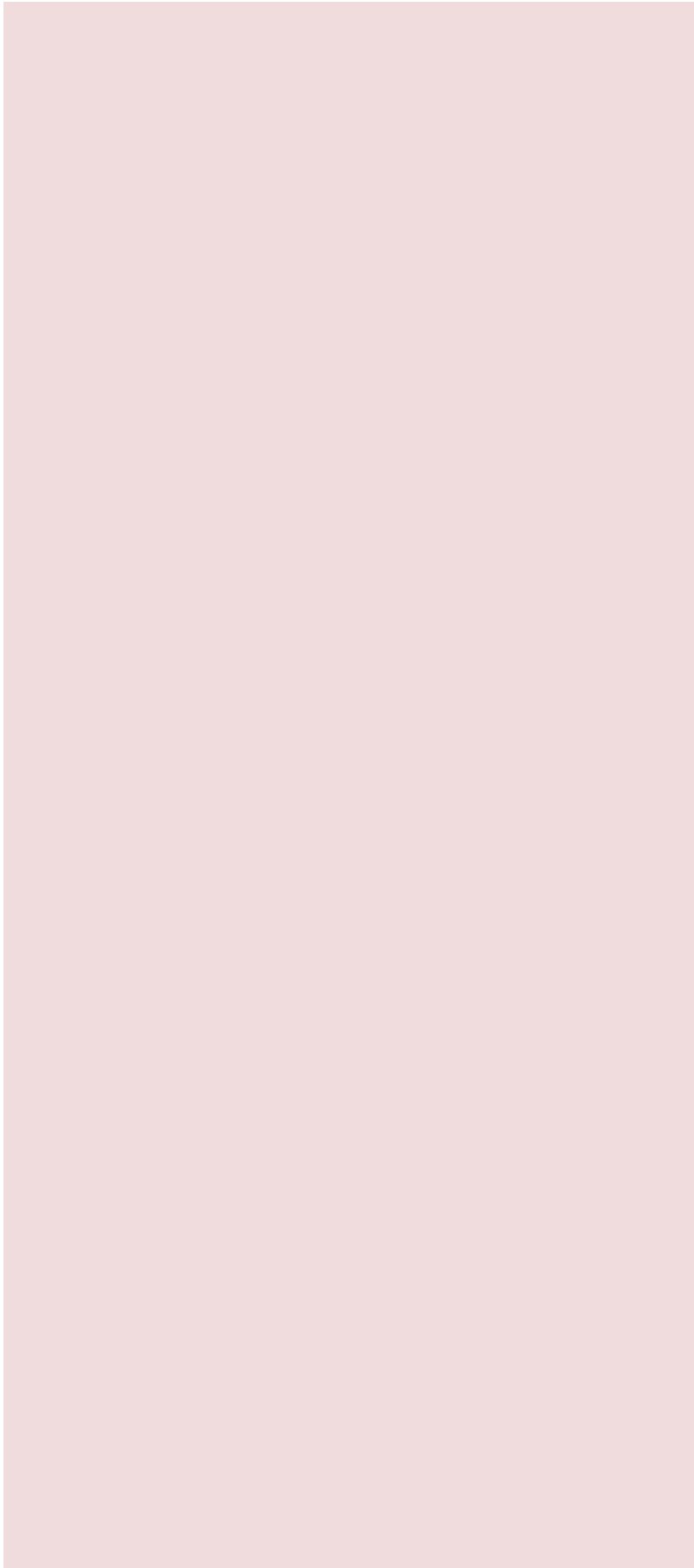
When finished, return the book. Fold the edges and sew them. With transparent thread, sew the canvas on the cover with needle.



STEP 7

Cut the fringes a bit to create different masses. That's it, your cover is over and you've learned a new technique!
