How to make a DIY saucer in lockstitch or latch hooking?
The lockstitch technique is making a comeback. Originally intended for making carpets, it is now available for many accessories. The lockstitch will put a touch of color in your home adorning your everyday objects such as a wall hanging, a bag, a cushion but also a blanket...

This tutorial requires the size of an iron.
Thanks to [Julie Robert](#) and [Edwige Mathias](#) for sharing her tutorial.
Before you start:
Cut strands of your 4 cotton colors about 12 cm long and group them by color to get 4 bundles.



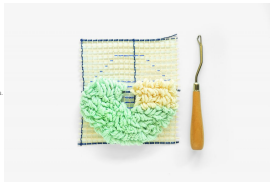
To prepare your strands go around a cardboard cart of 12 cm a number of times (we can count beforehand the points to be to make only the number of strands needed) and cut up and down

Step 1 :



Draw the pattern on the canvas by referring to Plate 3 or draw it freehand.

2nd step :



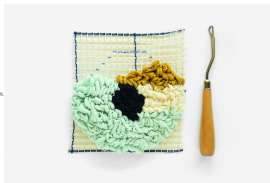
Make sky blue curls, starting at the bottom left, then cream curls.

Step 3:



Fill the center with black loops.

Step 4:



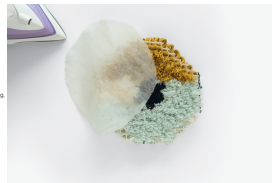
Finish with the top loops, with mustard cotton.

Step 5:



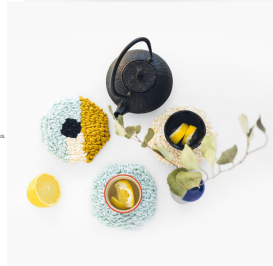
Cut the canvas around the pattern, about 1 cm from the work. Fold the edges upside down, using the tip of a hot iron.

Step 6:



Cut the fusible to the dimensions of the book. Glue it upside down with the iron to secure the loop threads and prevent them from loosening.

Your saucer is now finished! You can invite your friends to have a tea and enjoy a moment of relaxation to contemplate your creations.
