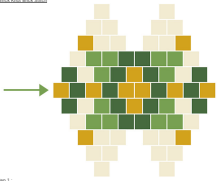

How to make a Brick Stitch bracelet with Miyuki and Star Beads?
In this tutorial you will learn how to make a bracelet with Miyuki and Star Beads. The Beads are glass beads designed by Perles & Co and sold exclusively on our site, other Star Beads colors are available. These beads can be used in Miyuki weaving, as a charm, or in combination with other glass beads for more complex projects.
This tutorial requires to know Brick Stitch weaving. If you are a beginner we recommend one of these tutorials to start:

Step 1
Cut about 1 meter of weaving thread and thread it on the needle. Start the brick stitch weave in the middle of the grid and continue to weave until you reach the same level as in the picture below.



Step 2
Pass through the white and green pearls and pull up a pearl further to continue weaving the second top of the weave. Add a single pearl on the left row of the top.



Step 3
Put on a Star Bead and a white Delica pearl. Attach the white pearl to the first top with the Brick Stitch technique. Join to the Star Bead and in the pearls of the second summit. Cross the weave and start weaving the other side of the grid in the same way. Add a Star Bead as explained previously.



Step 4
Repeat the pattern of the grid and add it to one of the already woven Star Beads. Wedge the thread into the beads and cut it when it becomes too short. Continue up to 8 to 9 Star Beads depending on the size of your wrist, it being for a wrist size 15-16.



Step 5
Take a new piece of wire. Pass it in one of the end one beads by holding the end of the thread on one side, you can also put a bead on the end of the thread for easier. Thread 6 gold seed beads, go through the ring of the T clasp, thread 6 seed beads and go through the hole of the Star Beads in the same direction. Go again in the set of pearls and in the Star Bead. Make a double knot using the end of the thread. Pass the two ends of threads through several beads and cut them. Secure the other part of clasp T in the same way.



Your bracelet is finished! Be aware that you can use the same material to make Miyuki and Star Beads earring and necklace.

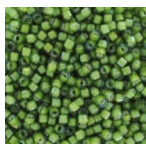

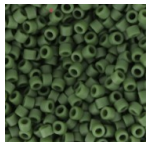
