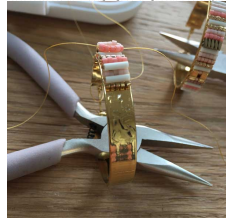


Step 4:
Thread 5/0-12354 on your needle and then pass the 2nd needle in the D6 in the other direction.

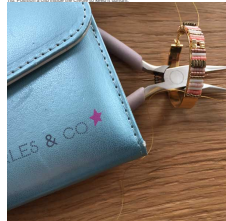
Continue in this order:

- 5x D8-00204
- 1x BGL-20021
- 5x Intermax SP-672
- 5x D8-00254
- 1x BGL-20021
- 5x D8-2114
- 5x D8-00204
- 1x BGL-20021
- 5x D8-00204
- 5x D8-00254
- 5x D8-2114

Step 6:
The weaving is stuck on the Crocle. At this stage, you can start to paste it, then it will be easier to continue.
Tighten and position the beads gradually on the bordered surface by aligning them (position the 5 Hematites in the same direction by rotating them on the wire before gluing them).
Tie the two ends of the thread from the beginning of the weaving to the back of the crocle, put a dot of Haskith glue, let dry and cut the threads.



Tip: Position a clip inside the C-peg to keep it undisturbed.

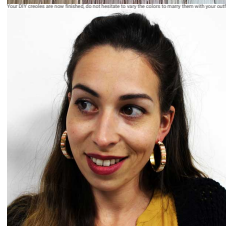
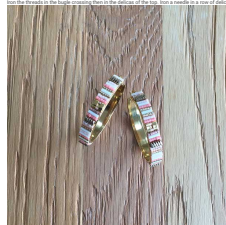


Step 2:
Continue with the following beads:
Thread a Half Tila HTL0191 = 1 x DB-1155 + HTL0191.
Insert the first needle into the HTL0191, thread another CO-1155 and pass the needle through the second HTL0191, pass the 2nd needle through the 2 beads.

Thread a Half Tie (HTL010) + 1 x DG-1155 + HTL001.
Insert the first needle into the HTL010, thread another DG-1155 and pass the needle through the second HTL010, pass the 2nd needle through the 2 beads.
- 1 x DG-2023
- 5 x DG-2114
- 3 x DG-2001

Step 2:
Give the weave by aligning and tightening the pearls well against each other.
Join the threads in the middle, recognize that in the middle of the foot. Join a needle in a row of fabric in order to have the 3 threads on the same side. Make 2 knots, cut a lot of rib, join the threads in a few rows of hands and cut the threads.
