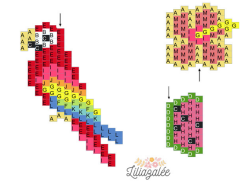

How to use Hama beads?

How to make a brick stitch weave with Hama pearls?

Here is a new Hama beads tutorial for you. If you're still looking for new DIY activities to do for kids during the holidays, this weaving tutorial with Hama beads is for you. By following this step-by-step, weave beautiful objects with the [Hama beads](#) stitch technique. The target is weaving, do not pass flowers and [Hama beads](#) of various colors with our various tutorials in our toolbox. Thanks to Aurélie for sharing her grids and her talent.

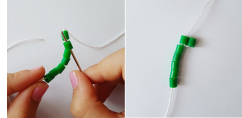


Tutorial for the watermelon slice.

Step 1: Take 1 meter of cotton thread and pass it through the needle. Thread 7 green beads, leaving about 10 cm on the other end of the thread.



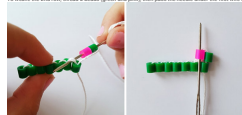
Step 2 & 3: Pass your needle through the 2nd pearl (it corresponds to the penultimate pearl thread). Pull the thread holding the rest of the beads. The 2 pearls are placed side by side.



Step 4: Continue in the same way (pass your needle through the 2nd bead from bottom to top, then through the 4th etc...). The first row is executed in order.



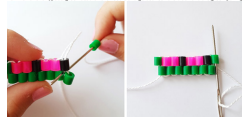
Step 5 & 6: To weave the 2nd row, thread 2 beads (green and pink), then pass the needle under the first row bridge. Pull the thread, and pass the needle through the pink bead from bottom to top.



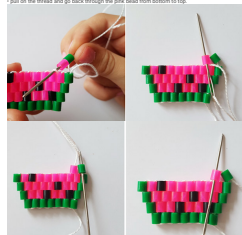
Step 7 & 8: To continue the row, thread 2 single pearl (2 rows), pass your needle under the wire bridge next to it. Pull the thread and pass the needle through the pink bead from bottom to top. Continue with the rest of the beads in the row.



Step 9 & 10: To finish the row, put a green bead on the needle and go between the black and the green (taking the thread that connects these 2 beads). Pull on the thread and run with the green bead from bottom to top.



Step 11: To follow the diagram, to start the last row, you have to make a decrease. For it: - put 2 beads (pink and green) on the needle, pass the needle under the " " thread bridge (coming from the right) - pull on the thread and go up and down by the pink pearl - pull on the thread and go through the pink bead from top to bottom - pull on the thread and go back through the pink bead from bottom to top.



Step 12: Continue to single point this row. To stop your weaving, pass the thread through a few pearls (engaging several times from bottom to top, and from top to bottom). Then cut the thread flush.



Little notes: You can start from an already existing diagram for Miyuki beads, but before your weaving will be on the one hand much larger, and on the other hand a little distorted (distorted in one direction). Hama pearls not having the same length / Width ratio as the Miyuki pearls, if you want to draw your grids on the Beadboard software, you have to change the grid: Go to "display", "module", in Appearance change pearl in width 16, and pearl in height 17.
