Which material to use for necklace wax and shell?

SUPPLIES



Tube terminator for 10 mm cord Antique brass x1

Ref. : ACT-230 Quantity : 2



Braided cord 10 mm black x2.80m

Ref.: BRF-200 Quantity: 1



Set of half natural Puka shells x 10

Ref.: CSN-121 Quantity: 1



Wax Fabric - Wedding Flowers - Violet / Yellow x20cm

Ref. : FABRIC-213 Quantity : 2



Hook and eye clasp 32x15,5 mm Bronze tone x1

Ref.: FRM-420 Quantity: 1



DoubleTerminator for 10 mm cords Bronze tone

Ref. : MTL-739 Quantity : 2



Jumprings open 9x1.2mm Bronze tone x25

Ref.: OAC-362 Quantity: 1



Acai seeds from Brazil 8mm Turquoise x 10

Ref.: PB-658 Quantity: 1



steps



★ Step 1/6

Cut 3 rectangles, with 2 measuring 5.5 cm wide by 45 cm long and one measuring 25 cm long by 5.5 cm wide. Fold each rectangle widthwise into 2. Stitch at 1 cm from the edge, turning the tube over with a safety pin.





★ Step 2/6

Pass the rope through the tube using the safety pin.





★ Step 3/6

Glue the single ends to the short cord and the double ends to the longer 2.





★ Step 4/6

Bring the 3 cords together, stitch in the center with a needle and cross the 3 cords several times. Finish by attaching a shell to the center.



★ Step 5/6

Wrap the top of the shell with thread, then pass a seed through it and sew it to the bottom bead, crossing over the 2 on top. Make 5.



★ Step 6/6

Connect the ferrules to the clasp with open rings.
