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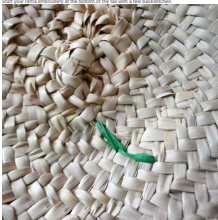

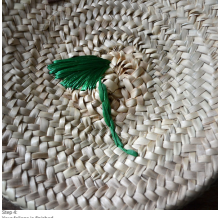

How to embroider a leaf?

Step 4: Once you've reached the base of your leaf, change thread to make the foliage. To embroider, start from the outside of the leaf towards the inside. (From the widest to the narrowest).
