

## MOTHER-OF-PEARL AND GOLD SEQUIN BRACELET

We suggest you to make a quick, easy and summery DIY DIY tutorial with iridescent mother-of-pearl chips and a 3 micron gold-plated chain. Give a holiday look to your look in any season! Want to customize your bracelet with other colors? Discover our chips in Amazonites or our mini-chips rock crystal. Also find our selection of gold plated chains for your DIY achievements. Step 1:

Measure your wrist and cut a little over half the length on the bilbao chain using the multi-function pliers. Cut again into two equal parts.

2nd step:
Thread a dozen mother-of-pearl chips on a nail and cut the nail 0.8 mm from the last bead.

Finish by forming a loop at the end of it after donning the mother-of-pearl chips. For more explanations refer to our technical sheet: How to form a loop on a jewelry nail.

Step 4:

Thread on a ring open a sequin and then clasp it to the loop of the nail formed previously. We explain in a data sheet how to open and close a ring correctly to create a jewel.

Hang a piece of chain on each end of the nail before closing it completely. Step 6:

Connect the carabiner clasp to a piece of chain and a ring on the other side to close your bracelet.
