This leopard-effect [leather lace](#) is more than just a print on leather. In fact, the leather has a kind of hair that gives the impression of real leopard skin. This adds a luxurious touch to the leather and offers a bolder design to your bracelet. This lace, combined with a silvered bangle, is both versatile and fashionable. To add a touch of authenticity, two black onyx cabochons are glued to each side of the bracelet.

This tutorial is perfect for DIY jewelry beginners who want to learn how to make jewelry while keeping up with the latest trends. Easy to make, this leopard effect bangle bracelet is the perfect accessory to add a touch of fun to your autumn and winter outfits.

Ps: In the video, we use Hasulith glue to attach the elements. You can use it yourself, but if you want a more durable result over time, we recommend using a two-component glue such as Araldite. This resin-like adhesive is one of the most resistant in our catalog.

Araldite Standard Adhesive - Bi-component - Progressive setting x24ml

Brass bracelet base with curved edge 10mm Silver tone x1

Leather lace 10mm Leopard x30cm
Ref. : FCR-092
Quantity : 1



Oval Cabochon 8x6 mm Black Onyx x1
Ref. : SEM-960
Quantity : 2

★ Step 1/3

Cut a 16.5 cm piece of the leopard leather lace, to check that it's the right size, and place it against the silver ring.

Glue the leopard leather lace to the bead using Araldite glue, then press gently to ensure it fits the shape of the bracelet. Leave to dry for a few minutes.

Apply Araldite glue with a toothpick to the black onyx cabochons, then glue them to the ends of the ring.
