Watermelon is everywhere this summer !

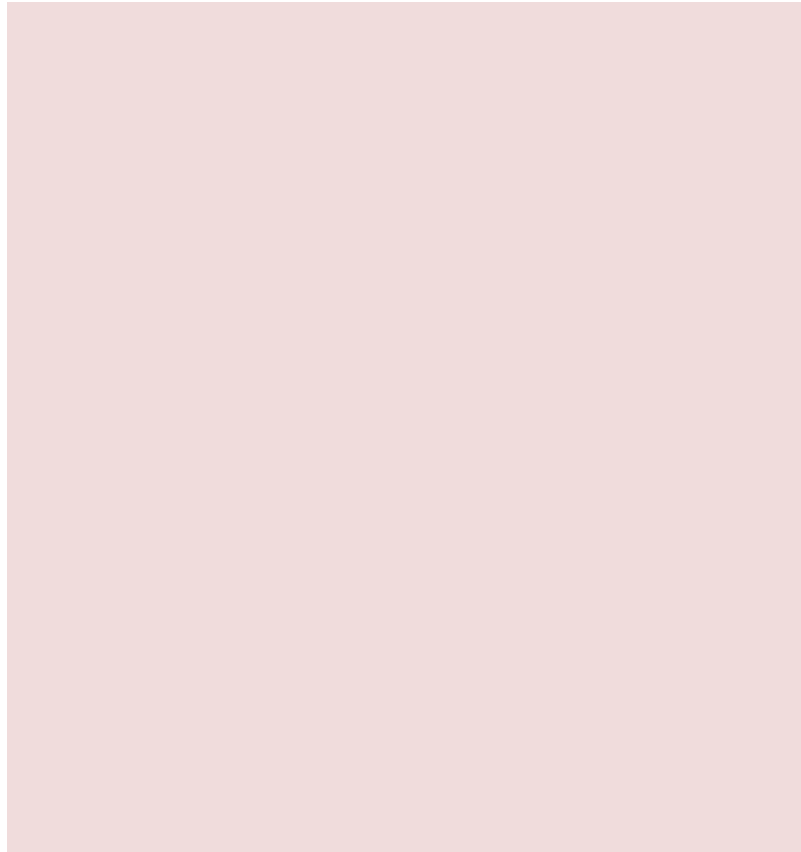

Here is the grip:

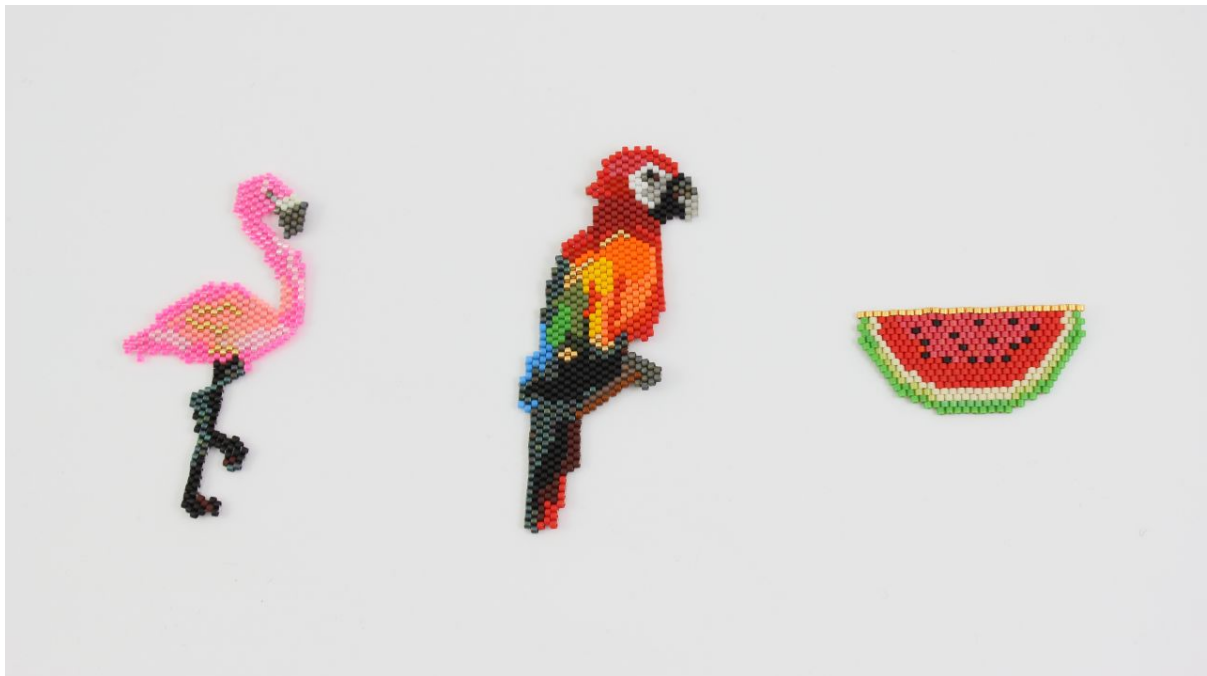


The color on top is pink and above is red.





You can also find other grid like a parrot and a flamingo.

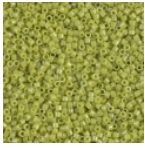

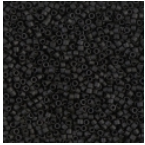

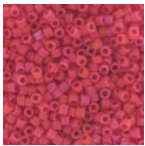
