How to make a round resin bead?

In this tutorial, you'll learn how to pour <u>resin</u> into molds to make your own beads with inclusions. <u>These molds</u>, adapted to resin, allow you to bring out beads that have already been drilled. Several shapes are available: round beads, flattened round beads and oval beads.
