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Jumprings open 3 micron 3.5x0.5 mm - 16 Kt Gold Plated x6

Ref. : ACC-443 Quantity : 2



Flat pad earstuds 6 mmfine Gold plated x2

Ref.: BO-738 Quantity: 1



1.6mm Brass cable chain - Gold Plated 3 microns x50 cm

Ref. : CHR-263 Quantity : 1



Half-moon pendant/spacer 2 holes 20x17 mm Gold plated 3 micron x1

Ref.: INTER-850 Quantity: 2



Drop Charm 8.5x4.3 mm Gold plated 3 microns x1

Round cabochon 6mm Black Onyx x1

Ref. : SEM-758 Quantity : 2

★ Step 1/3

<? if(isset(\$step['description']) &&!empty(\$step['description'])): ?> Glue 2 Pearl Cabochons to the spacers using hasulithtype jewelry glue. <? endif; ?>

Glue the onyx cabochons to the ear studs. Wait for the
glue to dry before touching them.

★ Step 3/3

<? if(isset(\$step['description']) && !empty(\$step['description'])): ?> Cut two 2 cm pieces of chain. Then assemble all the pieces using jewelry clips. You'll have enough chain left over to make a gold-plated necklace - how cool is that? <? endif; ?>
