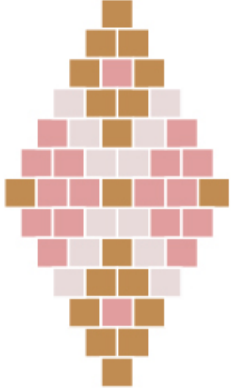
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How to weave pearls around a creole?

How to weave beads around a creole?

Learn how to weave miyuki pearls on a ring or pair of creoles. This is a very simple technique to learn, but it requires a little precision. You can use other pearls like seed beads and bohemian facets.

For the weaving of diamond in brick stitch we invite you to consult our fact sheets on weaving brick stitch.



Step 1 :

Fold the opening of the Creole to close it.

2nd step :

Cut 1m20 of thread and thread it on a needle. Tie the thread to the creoles leaving 10 cm of thread end. Thread 2 beads and fold them against the creoles. Pass the needle under the creoles and go to the second bead. Go back to the first and then back to the second one.

Step 3:

Thread a new pearl place it against the other two. Pass the needle under the creole and go back to the pearl. Continue to fix the pearls thus all around the creoles. There are 68 pink pearls.

Step 4:

To start the second row of pearls thread a white pearl and a golden pearl. Pass the needle under the wire connecting the penultimate and the penultimate-pearl pink. Go and go back in the golden pearl, then in the white pearl and again in the gold. You have just made a decrease in Brick Stitch.

Step 5:

Thread a white pearl and put it against the golden pearl. Pass the needle under the thread connecting the next two beads and return to the white pearl. Continue until you finish the row.

Step 6:

Wedge the threads into the beads and cut them.

Step 7:

Start the diamond in Brick Stitch by the middle of the diagram, ie the longest line / row. Thread a golden pearl and a pink pearl. Place them 10 cm from the end of the thread. Go through the golden pearl, in the rose, in the golden and one last time in the rose.

Step 8:

Thread a third pearl. Go into the second pearl, the third, the second and again the third. Continue to weave the beads of the line in the same way.

Step 9:

To go to the next row, make a reduction as explained in step 4. Thread 2 pink beads and weave them by making a decrease in Brick Stich. The method is then similar to step 5. Weave both sides of the diamond one after the other.

Step 10:

Once the last pearl of the woven top, go back into this pearl, go through the ring of the creoles and go through the pearl from above. Turn around in the beads to repeat the operation a second time. Then cut the thread into the beads and cut it.

Step 11:

Open the ring of the ear hook and close it on the ring of the Creole.

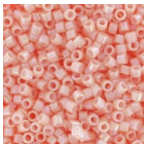
