

MEDALLION STAR DECORATION WOVEN GLASS BEADS STAR BEADS AND KITE BEADS

How to weave glass beads around a ring?



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This DIY video tutorial will allow you to weave a medallion or decoration with Star Beads glass beads by Perles & Co and Kite Beads. Then wear it as a pendant, in maxi earrings or decorate your guest table with this little table gift .

Star Beads are internally designed glass beads from Perles and Co. Pair them with other glass beads or rockeries for more intricate weaving.

The first step in this tutorial is to weave Miyuki delicas 11/0 beads around a ring. It is a technique increasingly widespread. Here are some examples of tutorials using this technique.

• DIY Creation Hoop Earrings Hoops Brickstitch Miyuki Delicas Emerald

Step 1:

Cut 1 m 50 of yarn and knot it around a 50 mm ring with a double knot. Leave a little more than 10 cm of end of wire. Turn 86 delicas around the ring using the technique derived from the Brick Stitch.

2nd step

Pull the thread out of one of the delicas beads towards the center of the ring. Thread 3 seed beads 15/0 and go to the pearl delicas next door. Get out of the next and repeat this step until you have secured 8 x 3 15/0 seed beads. Then go back to the last pearl delicas in which you went to turn around, go to the next one and then to the next one and place 3 more rocks. Turn around passing under the ring again. Pass in the last two rockeries. Thread a Kite Bead and go into the second rock of the previous group to fix the Kite Bead.

Go back to the last group of rockeries and continue to weave until you have 8 x 3 seed beads and repeat step 2 to go around the circle. There will be 5 Kite Beads. The last is fixed above two spaces.

Step 4:

Go to the top hole of the Kite Bead and string 6 seed 15/0, 1 Star Bead and 6 seed 15/0 and go to the top hole of the next Star Bead. Repeat this to go around the medallion and then pass a second time in the set of pearls to solidify the weave.

Get out of a Star Bead, put on 5 seed 15/0 and go into the second pearls of the 3rd group of rockeries. Also go through the pearl delicas below and turn around passing the wire under the ring then returning to the delicas. Go through two delicas then place a pearl delicas between the fourth and the fifth group of rockeries. Continue to go to the sixth group, get out of the second rock, put on 5 rockeries and go through the hole of the Star Beads. Step 6:

Repeat step 5 until you have gone around the medallion. Return to the bottom beads to pinch and cut your thread. Take a new thread and place a holding bead 10 cm from the end.

Between each Star Bead place 2 seed 15/0, 1 Kite Bead, 2 seed 15/0. Once the round is done, remove the bead, tie the threads and hide them in the beads before cutting. Step 8:

Take a piece of string again with a bead and this time tie the Kite Beads together to finish the center of the locket.
