How to weave Miyuki around a Creole?

We assure you, the Miyuki weave is addictive! That's why we offer a new model of woven beaded creoles. The technique is explained in several of our videos, do not hesitate to consult them if you do not know how to weave around a Creole or a ring with the Brick Stitch technique:

The colors of Miyuki delicas 11/0 pearls offered in this model come from a limited edition assortment. This is the [assortment of pearls Miyuki 11/0 "Kawaii"](#). Its pastel colors will allow you to create jewelry, pins or very cute patterns to put a little sweetness in your day!

We have chosen to put a golden crinkled sequin in the center of Creole but you can for example weave a parrot or a parakeet in similar tones and suspend them to creoles.

The pattern is repetitive, so you can adapt it to other sizes of creoles as well. These [mounting rings](#) are also available in 37, 26, 20 and 15 mm as well as gold plated, silver plated and rose gold plated.



Step 1 :

Cut 1.5m Miyuki weaving wire. Tie it to the mounting ring with a double knot. Start by weaving the two outer rows in white and blue, you weave the rose later. You can help videos mentioned above to learn how to weave around Creole. Thread a white pearl and a turquoise pearl. Place them against the ring. Pass the thread under the ring and go back to the turquoise bead. Tighten the wire and then go back into the white pearl through the hole farthest from the ring, then back into the turquoise bead through the hole closest to the ring.

2nd step :

Thread a new turquoise bead and place it against the ring and the other turquoise bead. Pass the thread under the ring and return to the turquoise bead. Continue weaving all the pearls in the first row this way. There are 79 pearls in the first row, 26 of which are blue triangles.

Step 3:

To start the second row, put on a white pearl and a turquoise pearl. Pass the needle under the thread connecting the two turquoise beads in the row from below. Tighten lightly to pinch the bead against the wire. Go back to the last turquoise bead threaded through the hole from which your thread comes out. Squeeze then go back in the white pearl from the outside then in the turquoise from the inside.

Step 4:

Thread a white pearl and pass the needle under the thread connecting the turquoise pearl and the white pearl underneath. Go back to the white pearl by the side where your thread comes out. Tighten and put on a new white pearl. Repeat this step until you have gone around the creoles. The chain is two white pearls and a turquoise pearl, then finish with a single white pearl.

Change the thread as soon as there is only 10 cm left. For that, wedge it by going through the previously woven beads and cut it. Take a piece of yarn and pinch it too, before picking up where you left off.

Step 5:

You will now begin to weave the interior of the creoles. Pass the needle in the turquoise bead next to it and in the one below to return to the center of the creole. Thread two pink beads and repeat step 1. Weave this bead in the same way as before by doing this as the top row did not exist. There are 69 pink pearls. Finish by wedging the threads in the weave and cutting them.

Step 6:

Open a ring by rotating its edges, not by pulling them apart. Thread the sequin and pass it in the ring of the creoles before closing it. Also open the ear hook ring and connect it to the creole.

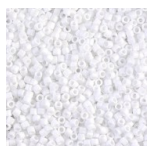
