

DIY VALENTINES DAY - CROCHET WOOL HEART

How to make a heart with wool?

How to crochet a woolen heart?

If you're new to crochet and want to get started on a quick little project to learn the basics of crochet, follow this Facebook Live broadcast on January 18, 2019. In this basic crochet video tutorial, you'll see the circle magical, the stitches in the air, cast stitches, tight knits, half bridles, bridles and double bridles to create a little woolen heart. Depending on the size of the wool or yarn chosen you can make a jewelry, a key ring, a coaster to decorate the table of St. Valentine, a kitchen pot or a carpet!

In this tutorial the wool is in size 6 with a hook for wool 6 mm. For a tighter pattern take a 4 or 5 mm hook. For jewelry you can take Lizbeth thread or Vega thread. For a much larger creation of the ultimate cotton thread 3XL.

Step 1 :

Create a magic circle. To do this, wrap the thread twice around your fingers then go under the first thread and catch the second thread and pull it by turning the hook. Then make a stitch in the air by taking the thread of the ball and passing it in the loop created.

2nd step :

Make 9 sts tight in the magic ring. Put the hook in the circle and go get the thread and bring it back. Then take the thread over the circle and slide it through the loop. Your first tight mesh is created.

Step 3:

Once the 9 stitches have been made, pull on the remaining piece of wire to tighten the circle. Make a slip stitch in the first stitch. Then make a stitch in the air.

Step 4:

Make 2 bridles and 1 double bridle in the next stitch. To make a bridle, wrap the thread once around the hook, sew in the stitch, take the thread of the ball and pass it through the stitch. Make a loop with the thread of the ball and pass it in two loops, resume in one and pass it again in two loops. For the double flange the operation is similar to the difference that you have to wrap the wire twice around the hook before stitching and you will have to go 3 times in 2 loops instead of 2 times.

Step 5:

In the next stitch make 2 straps.

Step 6:

In the following 1 half-flange. This one begins as a simple bridle except that when passing in 2 loops you have to pass in 3 at once.

Step 7:

In the next 1 stitch.

Step 8:

Then in the following 1 half-flange, 1 double flange and 1 half-flange.

Step 9:

Then we continue doing the reverse sequence. 1 stitch, 1 half-strap, 2 flanges, 1 double then 2 flanges and finally 1 stitch in the air.

Step 10:

Finish the heart by making a slip stitch in the first stitch and then making a knot.
