

## DIY MINI WALLET IN PUNCH NEEDLE

How to create a small purse punch?

Where to find a model in Punch Needle?

No need to follow the news DIY to know that the punch needle is the inevitable decor of the moment!

While we like this technique, a bit too much, Bérénice alias @Woolthatgirl presents a tutorial in punch needle but not any: a mini pocket to slip into your purse to put your cards, or any other precious little secret!


You can turn it into a nice wallet by adding a snap, you see ...

And since we are cool, you are even entitled to an explanatory video, rather nice no? You can also find the steps below, go on we go!

Step 1 :

Reproduce the pattern on a sheet, find the dimensions just below:





2nd step:

Cut a first piece of canvas to the correct size using the drum as a template, then cut a second piece to the same size.

To have both side of your wallet.

Step 3:

Place your first piece of cloth in your drum, stretching it out.

Do not hesitate to tighten your drum with a pair of pliers so that the fabric stays in place. And yes, it moves in Punch Needle!

Step 4:

Draw the pencil pattern on your canvas and then help yourself with a ruler for interior measurements.

Step 5:

Thread your wool in the Punch Needle with the needle thread (what a beautiful invention!).

Step 6:

It's gone to puncher! Start from the outside by going inward.

When finished, pass the thread on the back of the punch and cut it flush with the other loops.

Step 7:

Then make the other two colors of the rainbow (in the order you prefer.)

Be careful to stay flush with the canvas and do not pull on the wire or your work will be totally undone!

Step 8:

Repeat the operation with the other canvas to make the back of your little pouch.

Step 9:

It is time for you to sew the two parts, cut the fabric around leaving 2 cm then fold it to form a bead and place there pins to hold everything.

Step 10:



Thread your thread around the bead, starting at the side of the coin purse.

Step 11:

Leave an opening by sewing each side and pick up the work on the second side by gathering the two sides together.

Finish from below.

Step 12:

Finish the seam by passing your thread through the last 4 loops and cut flush.

And now, it's over ! You have just made your first creation in Punch Needle, so hitchy!

For stock concerns we offer an alternative to wool but just as similar!




